

# SMITH IS BOOED BY R. O'S. MEN

Johnson Supporters Hoot Down Doc Smith His Former Campaign Manager.

Becoming indignant when he started hurling epithets and slingling mud, several hundred ardent R. O. Johnson supporters booted down "Doc" Smith, former Farmer-Labor ticket adherent and speaker at a Hamilton meeting at Turner Hall, 14th and Washington street in Gary last night.

Aroused because Smith had seen fit to attack Johnson, part of the audience started to boo-hoo the speaker when he asked, "Do you want a man like that for your Mayor?"

Hamilton advocates did not get an opportunity to voice their sentiments and the Johnsonites took it up with an up roar of "Yes, we want him, we want Johnson, Hooray for Johnson," and for 45 minutes there was such an uproar that the crowd refused to let Smith continue.

It was only after some difficulty that Chairman Oliver Starr of the meeting was able to quiet the crowd and Smith continued, only changing his tactics after regaining the floor.

The Johnson demonstration probably came as a result of the announcement made by Smith at meetings earlier in the week that he would make the fur fly at the Turner Hall meeting on Friday night and if anybody wanted to hear something about Johnson, for them to be present at the meeting.

Likewise there was a large crowd on hand to hear the venerable "Doc" Smith exhort Johnson for whom he has acted as campaign manager during two republican campaigns. However, the audience was made up largely of Johnson supporters and when his oratory became so extreme, they booted him down and refused to let him continue in that manner.

The excitement started early in the evening after Oliver Starr had opened the meeting when a Johnson man in a front row seat got up and offered to wager a thousand dollars on Johnson, shaking a roll of fifty's in his hand. He was also booted down and finally left for the rear of the hall.

As a result of the demonstration the meeting was cut short.

## MONON WAGE CUT SLATED FOR MANY

Workmen's Representatives Meet for Discussion With Company Officials

LAFAYETTE, Ind., April 9.—Representatives of labor organizations of the Monon railroad met with the company's department officials here to discuss a proposed reduction in wages. The conferences were authorized in a bulletin issued several weeks ago by Harry Kurrie, president of the Monon, and in which notice was given that a general reduction in wages over the entire system would take effect April 18. The order includes all classes of labor, but excludes the four brotherhoods, engineers, firemen, brakemen and conductors.

Reductions proposed in the mechanical departments would be a return to a wage scale in effect prior to what is known as Decision No. 2, May 1, 1920, when the scale was increased to 85 cents an hour. This would call for a reduction of 15 cents an hour, or a rate of 72 cents for mechanics and 48 cents for helpers. Laborers in by Dr. G. L. Smith, who made the

yards and supply departments are to be offered a wage scale of 40 cents an hour, against 48½ cents now being paid.

S. E. Lewis, general superintendent met with representatives of other employees, including clerks, train and engine crew callers, station baggage men, janitors, elevator and telephone switch board operators, watchmen, freight handlers and truckers, common laborers around stations, warehouse and crossing watchmen, stationers, engineers and stationers, firemen and police departments.

The proposed wage scale would mean a reduction of 17 per cent, for the latter class of workmen. No agreements were reached at any of the conferences, as persons representing the various crafts must submit the proposals to their representative unions. It is believed, however, that the crafts will refuse the cuts proposed and that the matter will go before the railroad wage board for settlement.

This may be accounted for by the fact that the individual is reluctant to state in public what he is willing to state in private, believing that a public statement would only tend to center attacks on him and would accomplish very little.

The fact nevertheless was brought out by the chairman that the public is still on a buying strike, but the material dealer, the real estate man, the craftsman and the community are the losers.
