John Isenbarger, of North Manchester, banker, real estate dealer, business man and farmer, is a candidate for the democratic nomination for governor of Indiana. He strongly favors an adequate scale of remuneration for teachers from the first grade to the last year of the university post graduate school.

As president of the Indiana Fair Managers' Association and as head of the Wabash county fair, Isenbarger has long been a leader in bettering agricultural conditions through a wholesome stimulation of competition in fair entries.

Isenbarger has long been a party worker. He was county chairman of Wabash county and is now chairman of the Eleventh district committee. He was twice the party's nominee for state treasurer and was defeated each time by a narrow margin—once by a recount which gave his opponent an advantage of but 270 votes. He is an untiring worker for the good of the democratic party, is a loyal Hoosier and enthusiastic for every movement which is for the good of Indiana and the people of this great state.
