approximately 200 pounds of produce in the greenhouse. The greenhouse also allowed for the program to grow about 2,000 plant starts that were distributed among the program's sixteen gardens throughout Elkhart County, one of which is located on North Main Street in Nappanee.

The produce is then distributed at the Church Community Services food pantry and other pantries throughout Elkhart County. The greenhouse is set to be moved over the weekend of September 11 - 13.
