was that the credit system should
largely be dispensed with, and
that where it should be given it
should be extended to those only
who pay their debts or who prove
themselves willing by their actions
and words to pay what they owe.

By the processes of investigation
as invoked by the association it is
found out who are worthy of
credit, who are dead beats and
who should not get benefits for
insincere promises. The assoc-
iation learns who do not pay their
debts and these people are re-
ported to every merchant in the
state.

The organization is also a
"booster" club and will stand be-
hind any movement that is for the
betterment of the town or com-
munity. It is not an organization
to stand together to boost prices
but will be a benefit to the buyers
as well as the retailers.

Another object of the association
is to see that laws are not put on
the statute books that will be det-
rimental to their interests or their
communities.

The local association will be
simply a part of the immense state
organization and to start with its
membership will number about
twenty.
