3 FOR HIGHER EDUCATION. Of the \$50,000 American students in China, 95% are in high schools, one-half are in institutions founded and supported by the Churches. Many of these institutions have had no greater success in their cause, but their needs are just as pressing as the needs of larger schools; and you have only to remember that almost all the alumnae to measure the value of their contribution to America.

Each denomination has its own detailed budget, and will administer its own funds. Your pastor has copies of the budget; examine them for yourself. In the week of April 25th-May 2nd you will be given your opportunity to help.
