The Town Board.

The town board transacted but little business of special importance at their regular monthly meeting Monday night.

The tax levies for the town of Rensselaer were fixed as follows: Corporation, 50c; road, 25c; sinking fund, 15c; special additional, 20c; poll tax 25c, a total of \$1.35 on each \$100. The duplicate was ordered turned over to the county treasurer for collection. By this arrangement town taxes will not be due until April of next year, and the town marshal will be relieved from the work of collecting same.

J. C. Porter resigned as a trustee of Weston cemetery.

The report of the engineer on the Washington street improvement from the Makeever House to the river was satisfactory and was approved by the board and the work accepted. The total cost of the work for the above distance was as follows: Guttering, \$1554.20; rock, \$2,307.88. The town pays for the crossings and the owners of adjoining property the balance.
