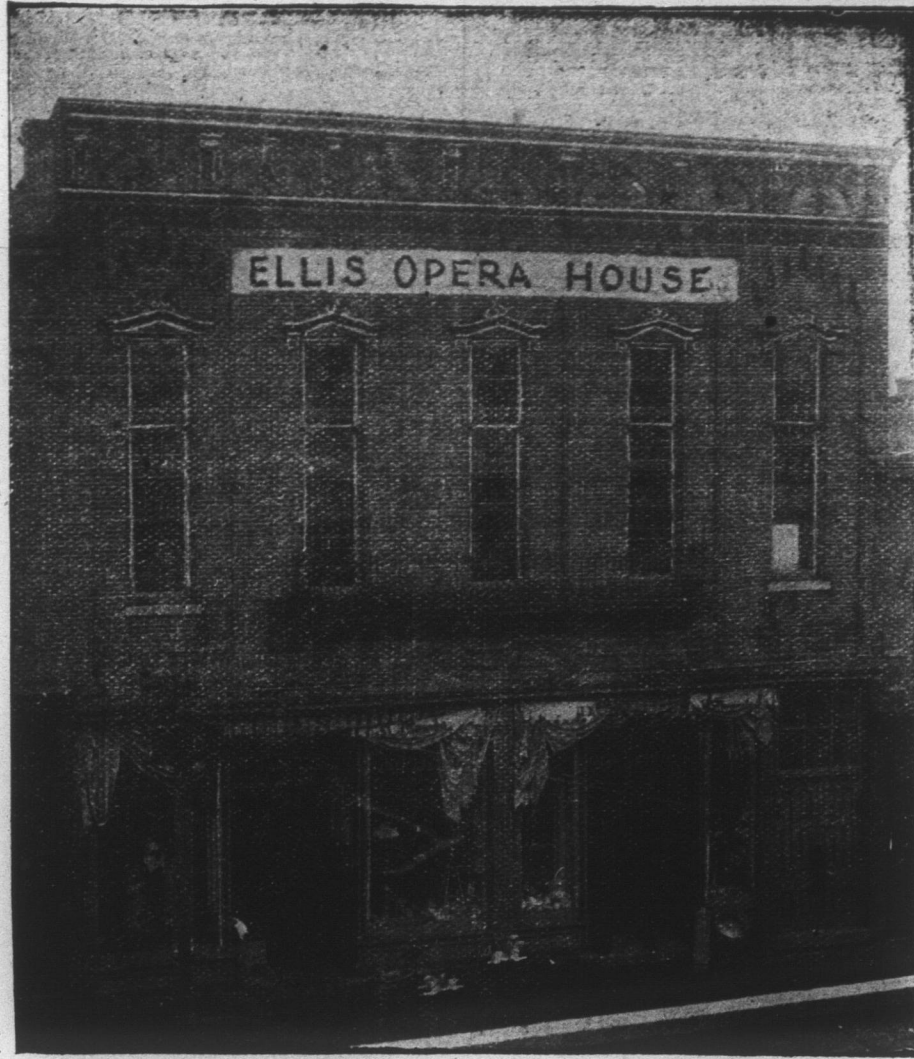
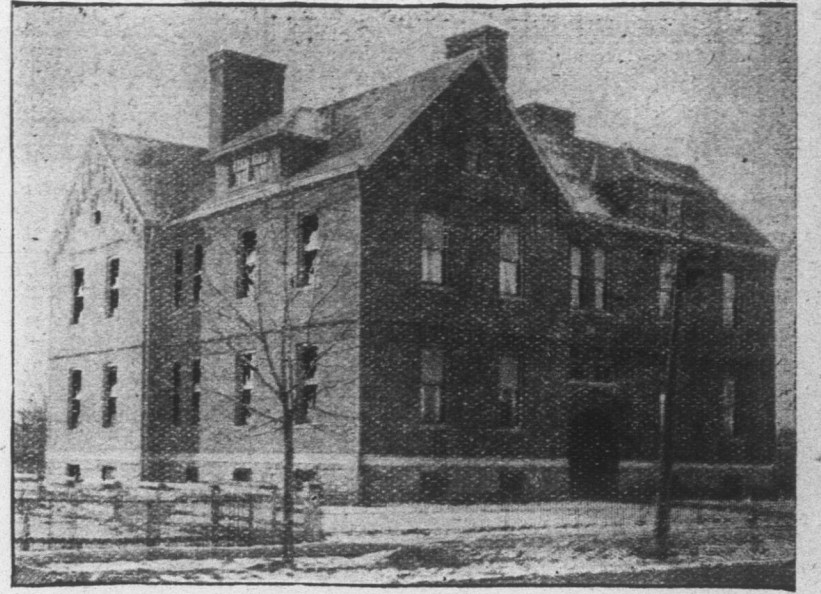


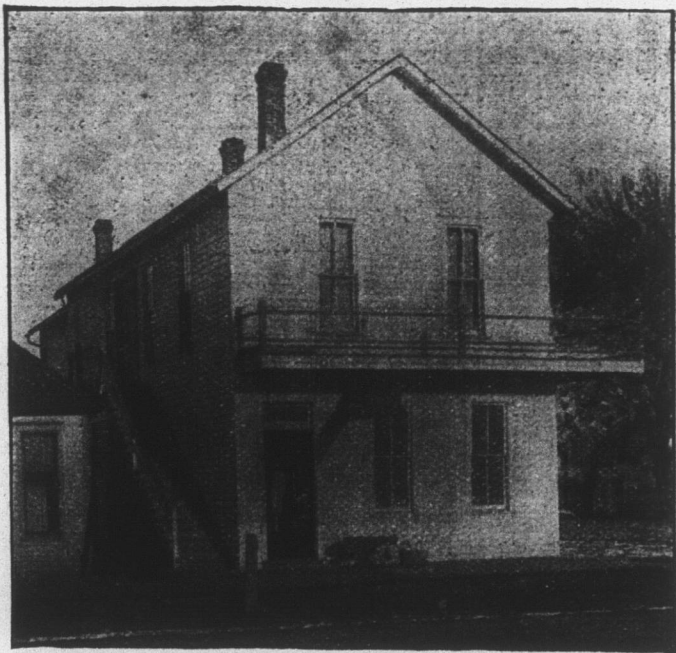
HIGH SCHOOL BUILDING, ERECTED IN 1884.



ELLIS' OPERA HOUSE.



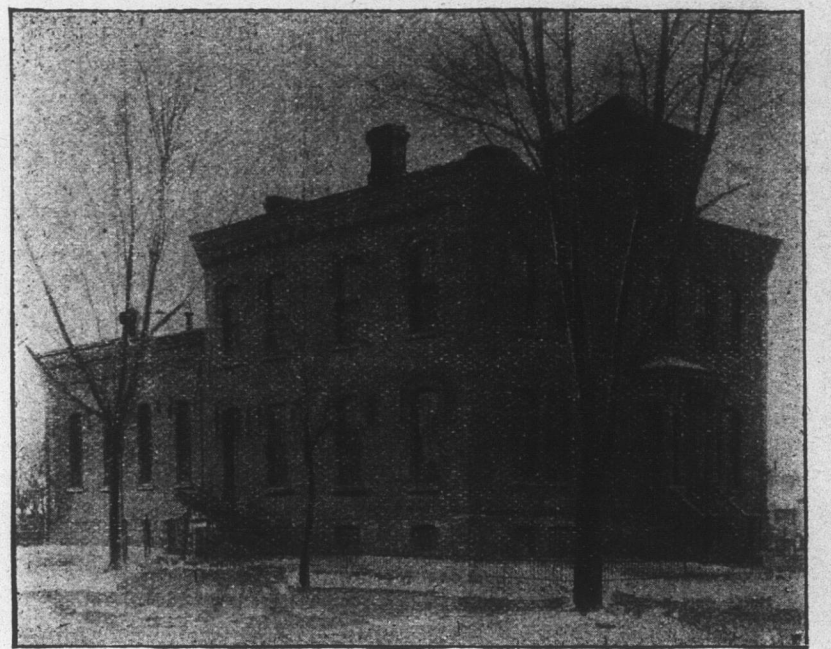

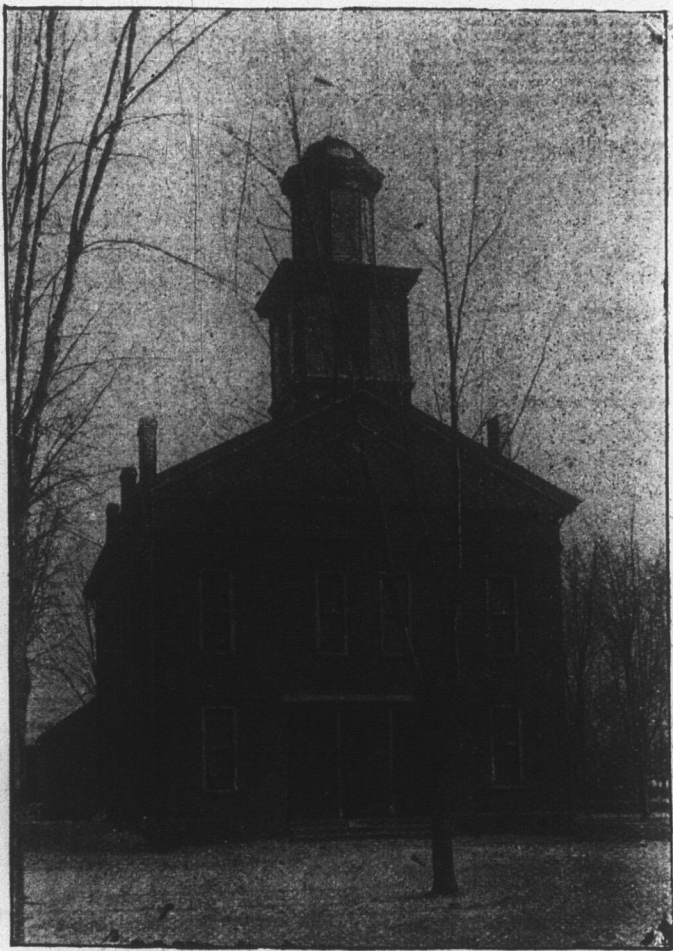

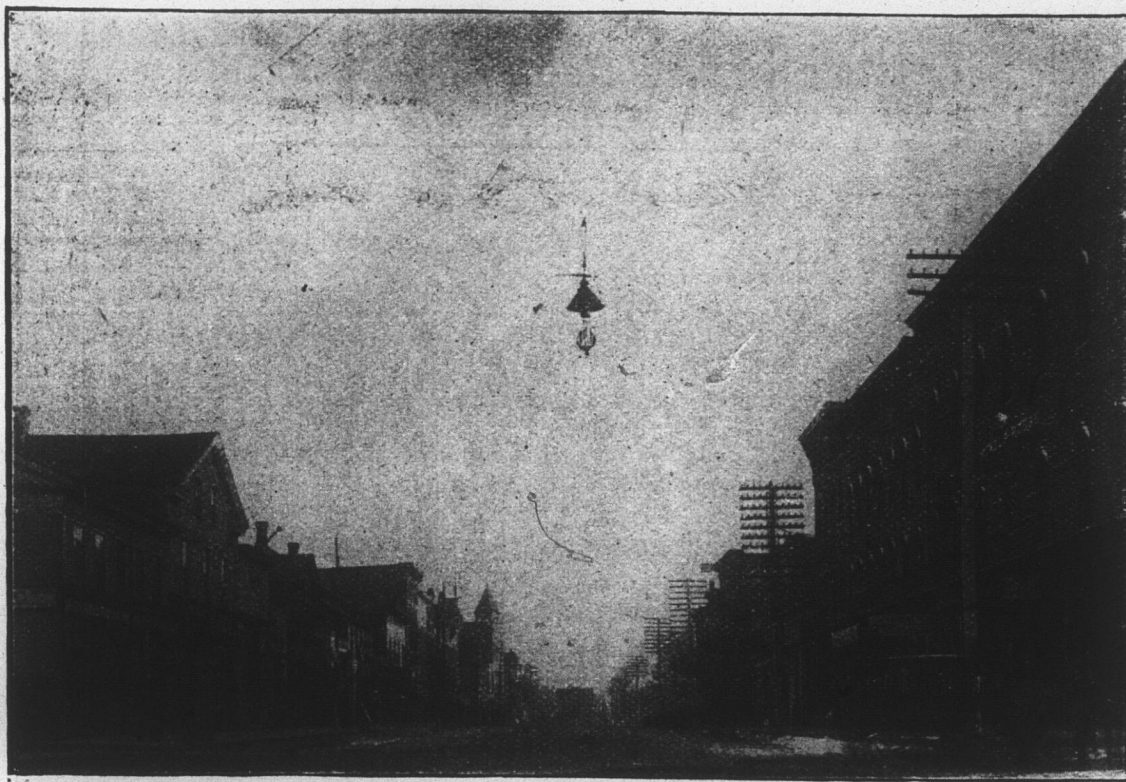

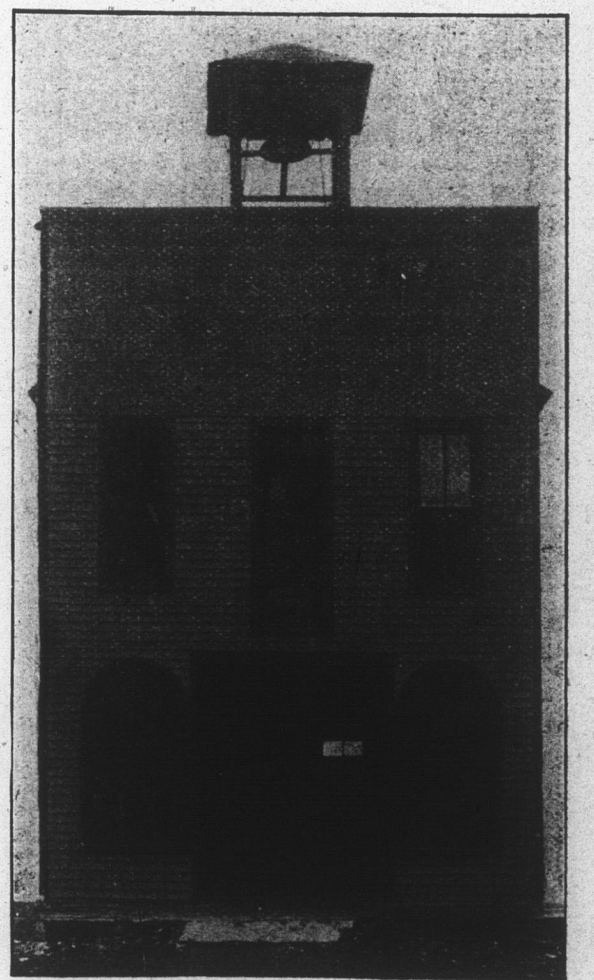

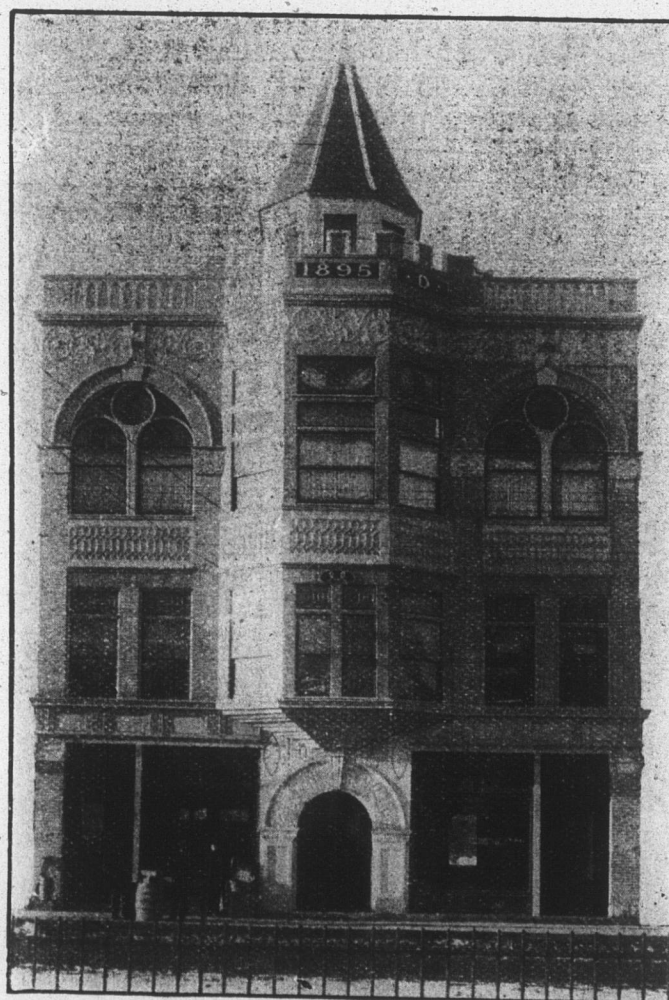

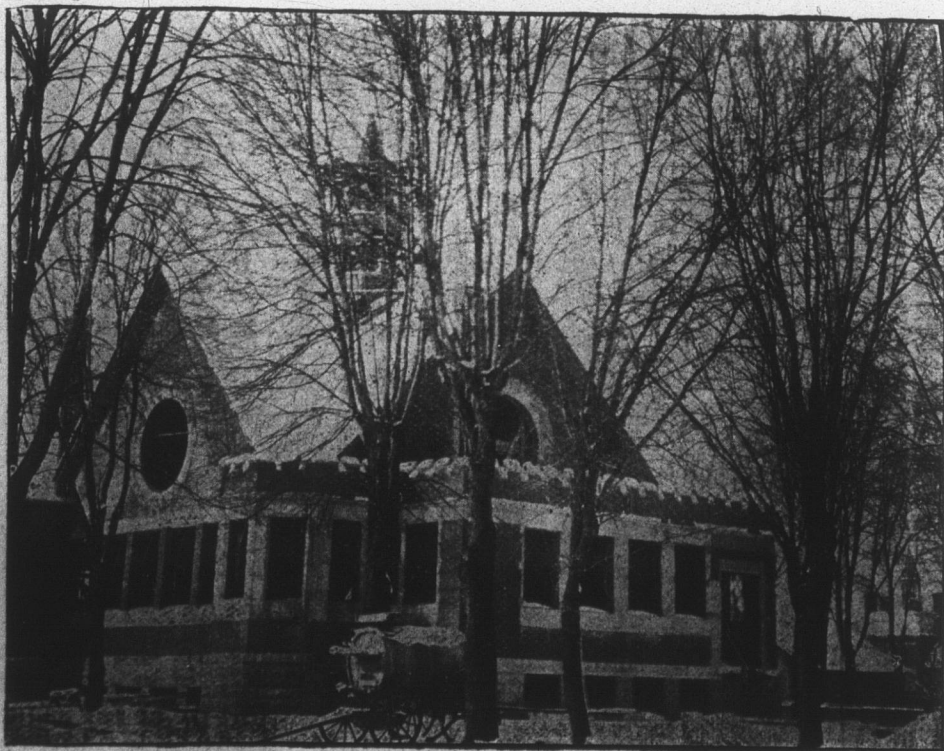
