The nominee for Vice President is a resident of this insurgent State, and it would look rather curious under the present system of things, as conducted by abolitionists, to have an "unconditional Union" Vice President from a rebel State that is ruled out of the Union by an "unconditional Union" administration, and which by a resolution of Congress can have no electoral vote.—*Fort Wayne Times.*

It is stated that no rebel infantry have crossed the Potomac; that the force which occupied Chambersburg was composed of three regiments of cavalry, with five pieces of artillery; and that a body of rebel cavalry is moving in the direction of Bedford. Gov. Curtin has called a special session of the Pennsylvania Legislature, to adopt measures for the defense of the State.—The Susquehanna River is to be fortified.
