## The Amnesty Proclamation.

The President has, at length issued a proclamation of Amnesty to those engaged in the rebellion, with certain exceptions therein named. These exceptions consist of three classes, and will embrace probably not more than four or five hundred persons all told. Those embraced within the executive clemency, are by the terms and legal effect of the proclamation restored to their former rights as citizens of the United States. This of course, includes the right to vote, but it is not at all likely that they will be allowed to do so by the radical Jacobins who have the control of the south. We think the President has erred in not sooner issuing his Proclamation, and in not making the amnesty universal as to all those engaged in the rebellion. This would not in any manner prevent the punishment of those engaged in the assassination of President Lincoln, they could be punished just the same then as now, the assassination being an entirely different matter from the rebellion. No good that we can see, will be likely to come of punishing Jeff. Davis, or any other of those excepted by the proclamation, and it seems to us that a full and free pardon to all would have done more than anything else to allay irritation and soothe the feelings of the entire southern population, thus doing away with one of the causes of discord and bitterness. If this had been done, and the fall elections prove, as they thus far are doing, that the political sentiment in the North has materially changed, we might hope for a speedy end to radical rule in this country.

Words of cheer are coming daily to gladden the hearts of democrats and all others not wedded to radicalism. California has gone democratic, radicalism has been promptly rebuked by the people of the Golden State. Vermont has gone republican by thousands less than heretofore for years. Maine has reduced the radical majority thousands of votes, and there is a fair prospect that next year she will be added to the list of democratic States. No where has radicalism sustained itself except where radical bayonets, as in Tennessee, have overruled the sentiments and stifled the voice of the people. Indeed we do not know of a single state west of the Allegheny mountains and north of Mason and Dixon's line, that will support the radicals except, perhaps Iowa, Wisconsin, and it may be one or two others. Never since 1840 has there been such an appearance of popular feeling as has now set in against the party in power, and all know that when once the people become aroused, it is impossible to stop the onward current until a complete change of rulers is accomplished. Democrats and all who love their country and sincerely desire its prosperity have reason to rejoice. Let them demonstrate their gratitude by laboring earnestly until the fall election is past, for the success of democratic principles and democratic candidates. The Iron Duke once said to those under his command, "England expects every man to do his duty"—the duty was performed and success followed. So let us say now, "Every man is expected to do his duty," and then let duty be done and all will be well.

The Valparaiso *Vedette* and *Republique* says the result of the election in California was caused by a division in the radical party, and the bringing forward of an independent Republican candidate for Governor. The independent candidate for Governor received about 1,200 votes, while the Democratic candidate for Governor received about 10,000 majority. The cause of the radical defeat may be traced to the overthrow of the Constitution by the radical party, their disregard of all law, their legislation to tax the laboring man to pay the interest in gold on the bonds of the rich man, and their legislation to territorialize ten States of the Union, in order to place them under the control of negroes, to perpetuate their power, and carry the Presidential vote of these ten States in 1868.

## More Developments.

The *World's* Washington special says: "It is alleged that further damaging disclosures of the doings of Ashley and Butler in their alleged conspiracy against the president are about to be made by the attorney general. Capt. Chandler, who formerly was in charge of the Washington jail, said to be a radical, is the supposed authority for the new developments."

## Burial of Gov. Helm.

LOUISVILLE, Sept. 10.—Gov. John L. Helm was buried to-day, at Elizabethtown, with civic and Masonic honors. The funeral was attended by the state officers and a large number of prominent citizens. No business was transacted in any of the state or county offices. The bells were tolled from 10 to 1 o'clock.

### The State Fair.

A Terre Haute dispatch says: The approaching state fair promises to be the greatest success of any thing of the kind, held in the west, for many years. The state board of agriculture have arranged with the celebrated manager, John M. Kinney, for a series of grand balloon ascensions, comprising a series of topical ascensions, a balloon race, and a balloon wedding; also a grand display of fire works each evening after the fair.

Secretary A. J. Holmes and Superintendent Jno. B. Sullivan have been on the grounds to day, and sold twenty five hundred dollars' worth of berths and eating stands.

The city council have just appropriated two thousand dollars to aid in fitting up the grounds in the best style. The mile track will be completed this week, and the amphitheatre adjoining the track, capable of seating three thousand persons, is also approaching completion.

### The Maine Elections.

NEW YORK, Sept. 10. A special to the *World*, from Maine, expresses the belief that Chamberlain's majority will not exceed 5,000 to 8,000; that the senate stands 7 democrats to 24 republicans, and that democrats count on a majority in the house.

BELFAST, Me., Sept. 10.

Four democratic representatives were elected from Waldo county, a gain over last year. The republican majority is reduced 1,300.

### FROM SAN FRANCISCO.

FURTHER ELECTION RETURNS. SAN FRANCISCO, Sept. 10.

Complete returns from 13 counties, and partial from 28 counties, make Haight's majority nearly 9,000. Nine counties to him from give a small vote, which will probably increase the majority for Haight. The total vote polled in the 13 counties mentioned is 45,580—Haight's majority 3,855. Some counties at the last general election gave a total vote of 59,647—an majority 8,479. The increase of the vote in these counties this year is 14,053.

Notwithstanding the most exciting election for many years the registration shows no decrease in the number entitled to vote.

The vote for Fay, independent republican candidate for governor, is about 1,200 so far as known,

Sixteen towns give Chamberlain, rep., 8,089, and Pillsbury, dem., 5,639, being a majority of 2,450 for Chamberlain a majority of 5,819, showing a democratic gain this year of 3,363.

There is a republican loss in Bath of 27.

Biddulph gives a democratic majority of 240 against 99 last year.

LATER—One hundred and nine towns give Chamberlain, rep., 27,415 and Pillsbury, 18,683. The same towns last year gave Chamberlain 31,650 and Pillsbury 16,565. Chamberlain's majority this year is 5,819, showing a democratic gain this year of 15,053 in the same towns last year, making a republican loss of 9,053.

The aggregate vote in these towns was 43,398, against 48,215 last year.

Total vote of the state last year 111,584.

This year it will probably fall a little under 100,000. Three-sevenths of the state is in, with a loss of nine-fifteenths the majority of last year. The same ratio will reduce the republican majority to about 13,500, or a loss of about 1,400. The democrats will gain representatives in some towns, but not enough to give them much power in the legislature.
