## SWEET PEA

A Word About Its Cultivation and Growth.

This beautiful flower is so universally popular that I want to say a few words to the children about its cultivation. I have seen the plants struggling for existence under the shade of a tree, or on the north side of a house, and have felt sorry for the misdirected efforts of the children. The two things most essential to success with sweet peas are an abundance of sunshine and water. They love a rich moist soil, but can be grown where the soil is not so good.

Dig up the ground and thoroughly pulverize it. Make a trench six or eight inches deep, plant your seed and cover with an inch of earth, pressing it down lightly. When the plants are two or three inches high fill in another inch, repeating the process as they grow, leaving at the last a small trench to retain the moisture. This deep sowing permits the roots to get a firm hold and retain the moisture during the summer. In watering them apply the water to the roots, and use the soap suds from washday for the same purpose, as it contains potash. Keep the surface dirt loose, and as soon as the little tendrils appear they must have support.

Cut the flowers every day for if seed pods are allowed to form the plant ceases to bloom. Last year I had splendid success planting in this way, but contrary to the advice usually given I planted the seed very thick, using a pound to twenty-four feet. I tried the experiment of using seed from different firms. Hendersons, Vicks, Burpees, also from three different groceries, and I failed to see the superiority of the expensive seed; but they were all fine, grown under the same conditions, and yielded a profusion of bloom during the entire season.

## VALUABLE SEATS.

In Paris Bourse Cost \$600,000 Each, But Bring in a Fortune.

(Chicago Chronicle.)

A seat among the 70 of the Paris Bourse (they call it a charge) costs about 3,000,000 francs (\$600,000), or sometimes 2,500,000, and a charge earns from 5 to 15 per cent (net) a year, so that the annual profits are from \$30,000 to \$90,000, or more in exceptional years. But these are usually divided among several associates, for it rarely happens that an agent is the sole owner of his seat.

More often he has paid for only half of it or a third of it and has three or four silent partners who own the rest and who may again have subpartners, so that you will hear of a sixteenth of a seat or even a thirty-second, these being simply investments that carry no rights or privileges on the Bourse.

As to procuring a charge, the thing has none of the Stock Exchange simplicity, where the main requirements for getting a seat is to be able to pay for it. Here a candidate must be a Frenchman and at the same time 21 years old. He must have served four years in certain forms of business. He must be personally acceptable to the agent, and often to his family, including the ladies. He must be passed upon by the 70 with formal voting, as if he were joining some select club, which he is.

There must be no stain on his business record and no slur on his personal character. A candidate was rejected recently for his bad habits and another for no fault of his own, but because his brother had been concerned in questionable transactions. With all this favorably settled, there is still needed the approval of the Minister of Finances and the sanction of the President. This makes it clear enough why many of the ablest dealers on the Bourse have not been members of the parquet, but of the coulisse. They could not get into the parquet.
