MAZY MURDERER ARRESTED

AND BROUGHT TO HAMILTON,
OHIO.

CAUGHT AT FORT WAYNE

Syrian Sleuth Does Some Very Clever
Work—In the Hamilton
Jail.

(Special to the Palladium.)
Hamilton, O., Aug. 7.—Through the energetic and intelligent work of Sheriff Luke Brannon and Joseph P. Aschar, a Christian Syrian, of Cincinnati, Ali Sahman, the supposed murder of Mahmud Hammzy has been run down and arrested at Ft. Wayne, Indiana.

The story of the murder in the Urnston school house yard on the Princeton pike early last Monday morning has been fully told and the progress of the pursuits, the capture of two Sahman's alleged accessories at Dayton and the continuance of the hunt after Sahman, the principal in the ghastly tragedy have also been related. But the climax came this morning.

Sheriff Brannon and Joseph P. Aschar had a long conference about the case early Saturday morning in which Aschar showed an astonishing knowledge of the habits, haunts, customs and routes of the traveling Syrians in this part of the country. Putting all of the developments in the case together and supplementing them with additional information gained from the two Syrians in custody, the map was carefully gone over, a theory was formulated which it was believed would lead to a certain knowledge of the course taken by Sahman in his flight.

Sheriff Brannon went to Ft. Wayne and found his man and brought him back to this city where he was placed in jail.

People do not realize that the shortest way from the quagmire of the modern unrest is a total forgetfulness of self, and few know that the healthiest nepenthe is to be found in reading. The word disease signifies the negation of ease, and most forms of neurotic sickness are a deliberate effort on the part of the invalid to make himself uneasy. If doctors were to prescribe a course of Cervantes or Moliere or Balzac or Sterne or Dickens or even Shakespeare and as strictly enjoin thoroughness in this course as they would if the treatment were a matter of diet or medicine, many of their patients would begin to mend from the first moment that these magicians had given them a forgetfulness of self. It is true that Poe declares in the "Raven" "vainly I had sought to borrow from my books surcease of sorrow," but the opinion of the world is overwhelmingly against him. Good reading is a forgetfulness of cares, and, by the same token, it is an education in all those qualities which make life sweet and greatly to be desired. It is the valetudinarian who most constantly tells one, petulantly enough, that he never reads books.
