Resolved, That we are unalterably committed to the temperance cause, even to the prohibition of the traffic in all intoxicating liquors.

In view of the fact that the liquor dealers of the state are perfecting their organizations in every congressional district with the avowed purpose of defeating the election of any and all candidates who favor legislation against the saloon.

Resolved, That we push the department of organization until in every town and village of our country the women are banded together for open and relentless war against the arch enemy of our homes, the legalized liquor traffic.

Resolved, That we extend our heartfelt thanks to the Friends of Williamsburg for the use of their church and to the janitor for his kindly helpful care of ourselves and our horses.
