**Princess Edna Studying Catholic Religion Preparatory to Wedding**

Rome, Jan. 5.—Reports in circulation to the effect that negotiations are proceeding at the Vatican regarding the forthcoming marriage of the King of Spain to Princess Edna of Battenberg, are without foundation.
