RICHMOND MARKETS

Grapes continued to lead the fruit sales in Richmond yesterday. Prices were firm, owing to the strong demand. Tokays are selling freely with Malagas not far behind. Apples sold in larger quantities than at any previous time this season. Prices hold firm, although receipts are unusually large. Peaches were of poorer quality. Pears were in fair demand.

Cabbage sales have been heavy, Holland seed stock being the favorite even at advance over prices of domestic seed. Onions are in heavy demand with the high-priced whites selling almost as freely as the cheaper reds and yellows.

INDIANAPOLIS MARKETS

Indianapolis, Oct. 2.—Receipts, 5,500 hogs, 1,250 cattle and 250 sheep, against 7,412 hogs, 2,565 cattle and 695 sheep a week ago and 7,460 hogs, 1,042 cattle and 112 sheep a year ago.

Receipts of hogs were smaller than they have been at this time in the week recently, and with rather a good demand both from packers and shippers the market opened at strong to 5c higher prices than yesterday and strong compared with the best time Saturday. It did not require long to place the morning receipts, and subsequently for a few late arrivals there was continued active competition and some of the last sales were made at the highest prices of the day.

Cattle—There was a falling off in receipts of cattle. This was surprising to the buying side, and as a result the market was lively compared with the close of last week so far as good fat cattle were concerned, and prices were strong. The situation as regards the common to medium cattle, was apparently no better, and prices were unsatisfactory as compared with those for good cattle.

There was a fair local demand for feeding cattle at steady prices, bulls were strong to higher and average prices of calves were a little better than yesterday.

Sheep—There was a small supply of sheep and lambs, barely enough to accommodate local butchers and there was active competition for the offerings, which sold at strong prices generally and in cases 25c higher than the close of last week.
