**RICHMOND MARKETS**

There is a considerably firmer feeling in the market for dried fruits. A slight advance has been made in prices of currants, and other advances are expected. Prices of Brazil nuts and of hard-shelled and soft-shelled almonds have advanced 1/2 to 4 cents a pound. Canned oysters are up 5¢ a dozen on one-pound cans, demand being unusually heavy. With more kraut coming into the market prices have declined 15 to 20¢ a dozen on three pound goods. Tomato prices are firm, with demand strong. Prices of cheese are expected to advance within a short time on account of the continued good demand.

## INDIANAPOLIS MARKETS

Indianapolis, Oct. 23.—Receipts, 7,000 hogs, 1,450 cattle and 650 sheep, against 9,273 hogs, 2,151 cattle and 293 sheep a week ago and 6,877 hogs, 1,486 cattle and 221 sheep a year ago.

Receipts of hogs were equal to requirements of local packers, outside buyers having few orders. Market opened with the bidding lower. Trading was active at a general decline of about 5¢. Some heavier grades were unchanged, but sales of ordinary light hogs were at times 10 cents lower.

**Cattle Market was Down.**

There was a falling off in receipts of cattle compared with a week ago, but there were as many in all departments as needed. There was poor demand for all kinds of steers even at a decline of 10¢. There was a fairly liberal demand for female butcher cattle, but at a reduction of 10¢ many cattle were unsold.
