

## "JIM" WATSON IS ELECTED BY A REDUCED PLURALITY

New Albany, Ind., Nov. 6.—Two hundred carbon envelopes, which it is asserted by the Republican leaders were to be used today by Democratic workers in buying votes, are in possession of the Board of Police Commissioners, and it is asserted they were found at one of the Democratic headquarters and confiscated. Several days ago some of the Republican leaders learned that the carbon envelope scheme, which had been worked successfully in previous elections, was to be tried again. A private detective was employed to obtain evidence, and as a result a bundle of carbon envelopes, prepared and ready for use, fell into the hands of the police.
