"If there is a freeze at the end of this rainy spell of weather," said a dealer yesterday, "it will not be surprising to see fresh eggs retailing from 50 cents to 60 cents a dozen. At this time of the year the thermometer and the price of eggs are at opposite ends of a teeter-board. When the thermometer goes up for a time the price of eggs goes down, and when the thermometer goes down for a time the price of eggs goes up. If it turns cold hens will not lay, and there will be no eggs on hand, consequently prices will be high. If it should be warm for ten days or two weeks, things will ease up as they did last winter and egg prices will drop."
