**Child Burned to Death.**

Portsmouth, O., Nov. 26.—Letta Wamsley, 6, daughter of John Wamsley of Rome, near here, was burned to a crisp. She was left alone while her parents went to church. When they returned the charred body of the unfortunate child was found in the sitting room. The child, who was an invalid all its life, got too near the grate and her clothes ignited. Being maimed, she was unable to arouse anyone and met death in pitiable form.

Ann Arbor, Mich., Nov. 26.—By the accidental discharge of a revolver in the hands of a fellow student John Ross Fraser of Genesee, N. Y., was fatally shot through the abdomen and died at the university hospital. Several students were standing on a bridge shooting at a tin can in the river when the revolver was accidentally discharged. Fraser belonged to the engineering department of the University of Michigan class of 1909.
