HAS BOUGHT LAND NEAR SANFORD, FLA.

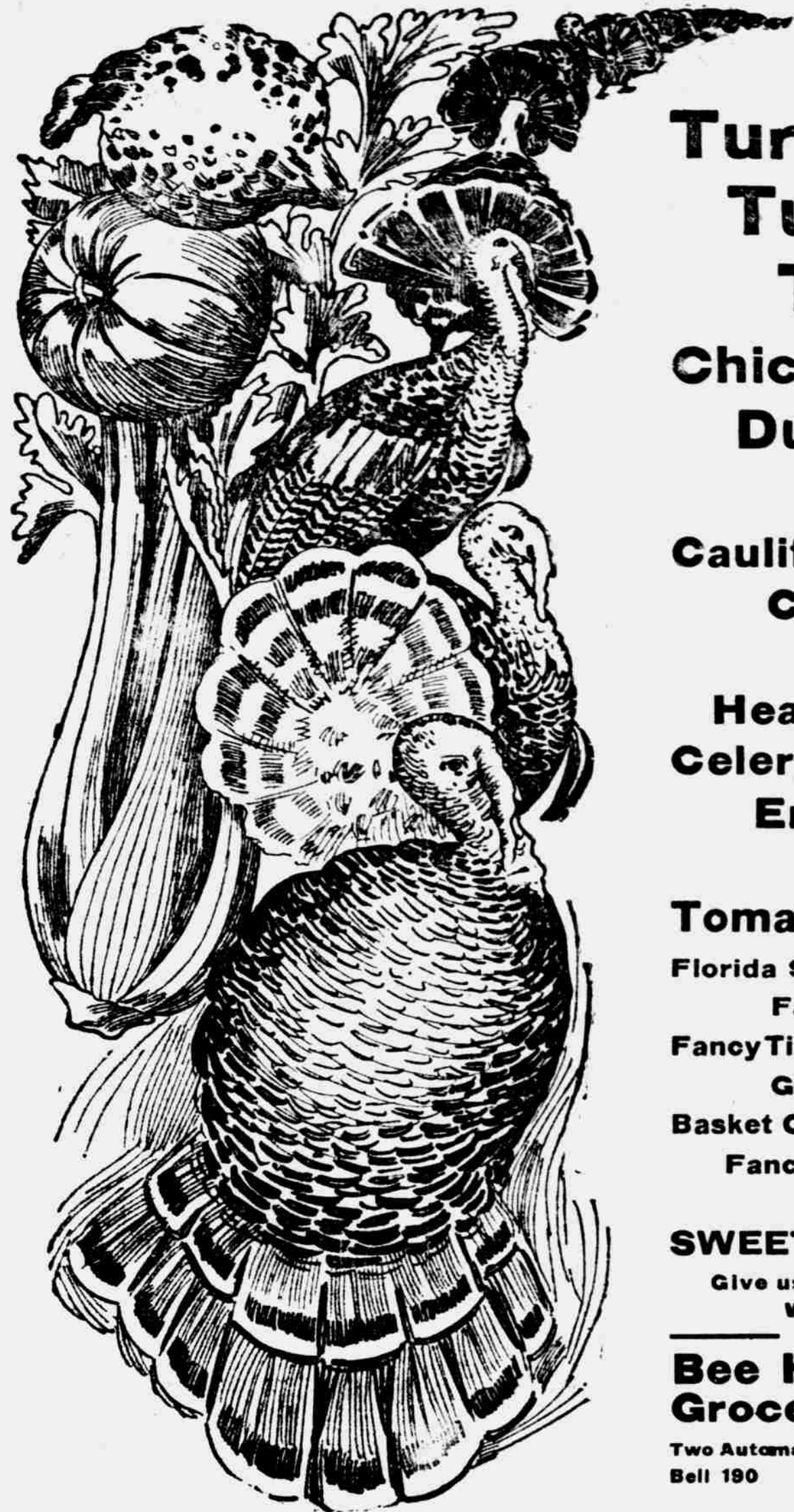
Dr. C. M. Hamilton Is Pleased With Florida.
