FROM THE GRAVE BROWN'S BODY TAKEN Widow Wished Photograph of Spouse.

New York, Jan. 1.—The unusual procedure of exhuming a body 20 days after it had been buried in order that a photograph might be secured of a man who in life had shunned the camera, was witnessed at Woodland cemetery today.

Henry Brown, train starter at the One Hundred and Twenty-ninth street elevated station, was buried Dec. 6. Mrs. Brown had no picture of her dead husband, and this so preyed upon her that yesterday she obtained a permit to exhume the body. The photograph was taken in an improvised tent, and the body was immediately reinterred.

OVER SIX HUNDRED ARRESTS MADE IN CITY LAST YEAR

Record Compares Favorably With Past Years and Cannot Be Equalled by Any Other City in Indiana of Its Size

SPEAKS WELL FOR RICHMOND MORALS SAY POLICE

Of the Forty-six Charges on Which Arrests Were Made, Intoxication Led All Others—Many of Combative Mood.

During the past year, the members of the Richmond police department arrested a total of 625 people on forty-six various charges. The record made by the police is about the same as that made in 1906. For a city the size of Richmond the number of people arrested is small. Such a small record cannot be pointed to by any other city of like size in this state. It speaks well for the morals of the city, say the police. As usual the majority of those arrested was on a charge of intoxication. Seventy-nine people charged with assault and battery and forty-six people charged with petit larceny were taken into custody. The list of arrests made last year follows:
