GOVERNOR JOHNSON WILL WAGE FIGHT

Desires to Be Next Democratic Nominee for President. He Says.

HAS NO UNDERSTANDING.

NO AGREEMENT BETWEEN HE AND BRYAN—PREDICTS HE WILL TAKE MINNESOTA FROM BRYAN FORCES.

Chicago, March 21.—Governor John A. Johnson of Minnesota last night authorized a formal announcement of his candidacy for the democratic nomination for the presidency. Writing from St. Paul to the Chicago Record-Herald, his private secretary says:

"Governor John A. Johnson is a candidate for the presidential nomination of the democratic party. He authorizes me to make this statement in his behalf."

He is something less than an aggressive candidate in that he is making and will make no organized systematic effort to secure the nomination. He is something more than a receptive candidate, because in a quiet and dignified way he and his friends are looking after his interests and because the governor and his friends will control the delegation from this state to the Denver convention, and Minnesota with substantially unanimous voice will present her candidate, the man who can win at the polls, to the national democracy."

"Governor Johnson authorized this announcement to be made because I pointed out to him that almost everywhere exists as to his present attitude and future course. So many rumors and conflicting statements concerning him have been in circulation that the people do not know what to believe."

"It has been said that he not only would not be a candidate, but that he would soon formally forbid the use of his name as a candidate against Mr. Bryan; that he had an understanding with Bryan by which he was not to oppose the Nebraskan. This he denied tonight."
