Magdalena, March 31.—Rear Admiral Charles S. Sperry, who will succeed to the command of the Atlantic battle fleet July 1, at San Francisco after Rear Admirals Evans and Thomas have been relieved, will retain the Connecticut as his flagship for the world-girdling trip from the Golden Gate.

Speaking of the trip to Japan, Australia, the Philippines and on through the Suez canal to New York, Admiral Sperry declared that it presented no great natural difficulties. "It is just like the cruise we are now finishing, only more of it," he said.
