A CHINESE EXODUS HE WAS WORTH \$30

In Ten Years All Celestials Will Leave America, Says Investigator.

EMPLOYMENT AT HOME.

Winnipeg, Manitoba, Dec. 19.—In ten years there will not be a Chinaman left in the United States or Canada, was the statement made last night by Lau Sz Kiv, imperial investigator, appointed by the Chinese government to inquire into mining, agricultural and commercial matters on this continent, with a view to the organization of an era of development in China.

With him are Law A. Yan, Yip Yen and Ou Wan Yow, three merchants of China, who are seeking out Chinamen well versed in various lines of trade and commerce, that they may be sent back to China to work for a syndicate which has been formed with a capital of \$3,000,000 to build railroads, steamships, develop mines, farms and engage in banking and general business.

The company has already been started and will soon begin operations in the province of Kweng Si, and Yep Yen, president of the concern, said hundreds of other companies will be put in operation as soon as the company now being organized has started work, and China will induce her countrymen on this continent to return to China, and the inducements are being offered by the government for the development of the country are so great that every Chinaman will respond to the call.
