CHILDREN FED

Annual Dinner to Poor Given
by the Penny Club at
Noon Today.

WILD RUSH FOR TABLES

AFTER A CHICKEN FEAST THE
HAPPY YOUNGSTERS WERE
GIVEN TOYS, PEANUTS AND
CANDY.

There are about 400 children of the
city who think the women of the
Penny Club are about the best Santa
Claus in the world. The annual poor
children's dinner given by the club to
day at the Pythian temple was com-
plete success. There were 360 tickets
given out but there were many more
than this number served and it was
estimated after the second lot of chil-
dren had taken their seats that from
400 to 425 had participated in the
feast.

Long before the doors to the Pythian
temple were thrown open and the
hungry poor and in some instances
ragged children of both sexes were
admitted. The sidewalk was thronged
with the children. It was a very amus-
ing sight, as well as a pathetic one to
see them. At 11:30 when the doors
were opened and the children permitted
to assemble at the tables there was
one mad rush. They were seated
at the four long tables, decorated with
holly and other greenery. Previous
to partaking of the meal Rev. Hobson
made a short address on the observ-
ance of Christmas in other countries
and he was followed by the Rev. C.
Beck who lead in prayer. Rev.
Keates of the South Eighth Street
Friends church officiated at the sec-
ond serving in a similar capacity. Not
until about 1:30 were all of the chil-
dren fed. The club this year restricted
the dinner to the youngest chil-
dren and the poorest and there were
some there not more than 3 feet tall
and 4 years of age.

A stewed chicken dinner, such as
perchance many had never had before
was served. The dinner had all the
"trimmings," just one item as to the
vastness of dinner will be given to
illustrate the capacity of the children.
Two hundred pounds of chicken was
eagerly devoured.

The club members decorated two
Christmas trees. Of course all of the
presents given out were not hung on the
trees but a number were. To each
child was given a sack of candy or peanuts
also presents including books,
toys, games, etc.

The Penny Club is given credit for
being the leading charitable organiza-
tion of the city. The entire ex-
pense will be taken from the club
treasury and is no small item. It will
total about \$100.
