the family physician, Dr. Fowler, who was at his country place at Pelham Manor. He jumped into his automobile and came down from Pelham at full speed but arrived fifteen minutes after Mr. Rogers died, at 7:30 this morning. Rogers was born in Fair Haven, Mass., in 1840. His parents were working people and did not have much money. They gave their boy a high school education and then put him to work as a delivery boy in a grocery store at \$3 a week.
