Worcester, Mass., Jan. 13.—The plant of the George C. Whitney company, the largest manufacturer of valentines and Easter cards in the world, is in ruins. 550 persons are out of employment and a shortage in the valentine trade is threatened as a result of a fire that swept the factory during a greater part of last night and kept the firemen fighting until early this morning. The total damage is estimated at \$300,000.
