

REPAIRS TO COURT HOUSE TO BE MADE

General Overhauling Will Be Undertaken Within Year, Commissioners Say.

Court house repairs which have been needed for the past several years will not be neglected much longer according to the promise of chairman R. N. Beeson of the board of county commissioners who Saturday declared that the county was just adding expense upon itself by neglecting the much needed improvements. Some of the rooms in the building he declared, look like smoke houses, and the roof of the building is a positive wreck.

A stitch in time saves nine, is his opinion, and he believes the stitch should be taken at once in order that there will be no repetition of the Danville, Ind., affair. The court house in that city is almost a total wreck, repairs being neglected so long that the roof of the public building finally collapsed. Since the Wayne county house was built in the nineties there has been but very little money spent for repairs. As a consequence the roof is leaky, in some places almost like a sieve. Some of the marble slabs have fallen from position, and the mural and ceiling decorations are almost obliterated by virtue of the years of accumulated dust, dirt and smoke. Laboratories are in bad state of repair.

The board has taken no official action on the matter. The appropriation sufficient to make all the needed repairs would amount to several thousands of dollars.

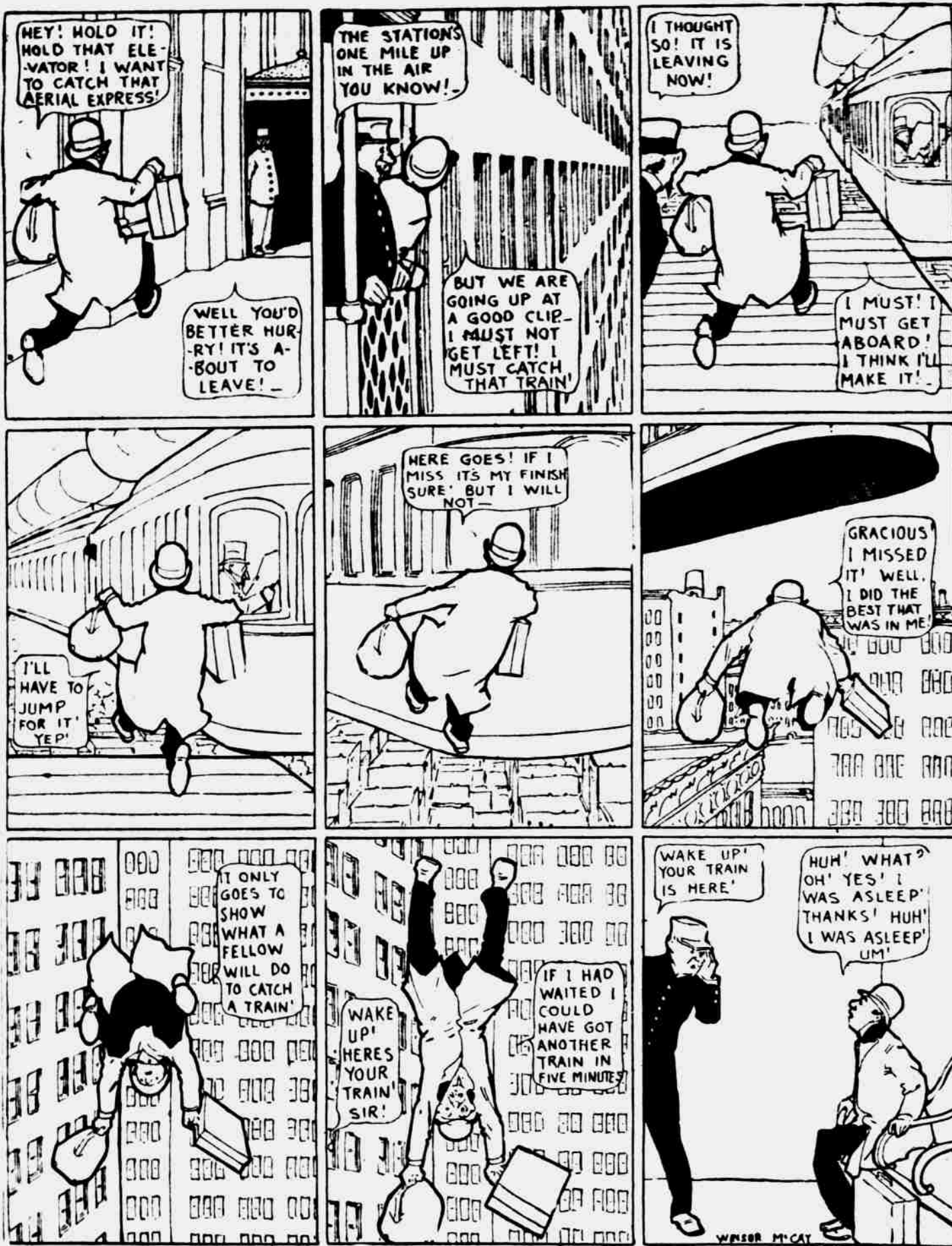

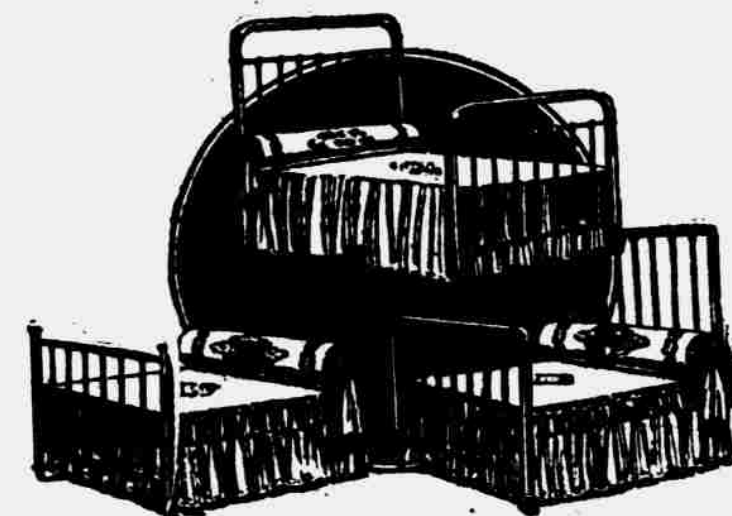
