

"FIRE BUGS" GIVE CITY WIDE BERTH

Chief Miller Declares Richmond Has Been Fortunate Along This Line.

Professional incendiarism is drifting from the larger cities to small cities and towns, says Fire Chief Ed Miller, who has made investigations into reports given at the International Fire Chief's convention in New York city last week. The fire chief claims that Richmond is one of the few cities of its size which is almost free of arson.

Associations of underwriting companies have been influential in securing data which go to confirm the statements of the chief. He claims that Richmond is peculiarly fortunate in having escaped work of "fire bugs." "I believe this is the only city in the state where over insurance is not practiced to any great extent," said the chief. "The practice of insuring buildings for more than the value is a sure sign that 'fire bugs' are ready to enter a town."

A report is now being made by representatives of underwriting companies of the exact amount of insurance carried by citizens of Richmond. This is being done in order to prevent over insuring and the cheating of the insurance companies.
