

# INFERNAL MACHINE KILLS ILLINOIS MAN

Authorities Investigate Death  
of F. N. Mennerich, a Former Counterfeiter.

**SULLIVAN, Ill., March 3.**—Sheriff Langdon of Moultrie county began the investigation of the death of Frederick W. Mennerich, the expert mechanic who was blown to pieces by an infernal machine. The local authorities were aided by post office department and Mrs. Donna Mennerich, widow of the former counterfeiter. She is said to have given the authorities a list of counterfeiters who were formerly friends of her husband, but who had lately turned against him because he quit making spurious coin and had furnished the government with information. The explosion resulted from his efforts Sunday to remove the outer covering of the infernal machine, and tore off his arms, badly injured his body and blew out one side of the room.

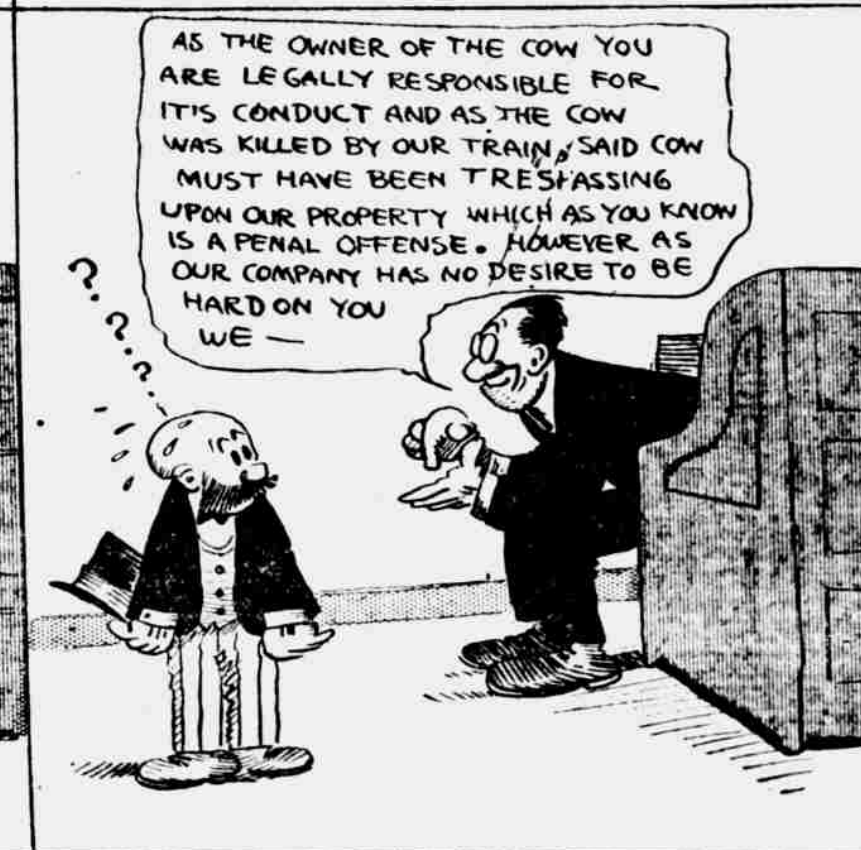
