## WHEAT PRICE HIGH AS MARKET OPENS

CHICAGO, March 31.—The wheat market was strong at the start today and prices were  $\frac{1}{4}$ c to  $\frac{3}{4}$ c higher. Profit taking was on after the initial rush, and the market reacted sharply. Crop reports continued to be unfavorable, though a few reports showing improvements have come from Illinois. Corn was firm with opening prices  $\frac{1}{4}$ c higher. Buying in the corn pit was induced by the upturn in wheat but later eased off when wheat prices dropped. Oats were  $\frac{1}{4}$ c to  $\frac{1}{2}$ c lower caused by selling by commission men. Provisions were weak and lower.

With the exception of corn, which closed at advances of  $\frac{1}{4}$ c to  $\frac{3}{4}$ c, the entire speculative list ruled lower. By taking of wheat by foreigners in all position in the United States and Canada was estimated at one to two million bushels.
