

## PREBLE NORMAL MAY BE CLOSED; STUDENTS LACK

School May be Moved to Eaton—Earl Harrison Funeral Probably Sunday.

EATON, O., Aug. 29.—Probabilities are the Preble County Normal school at West Alexandria will be closed for at least a year, following the resignation of Miss Zetta Huber, head of the school, who has resigned to take an instructor's position in the State Normal school at Greensboro, S.

County School Superintendent Walter S. Fogarty states that the school at West Alexandria will very likely be discontinued, probably for a year at least, owing to the fact that the attendance at present is not sufficient to warrant its continuance. However, the situation probably will be clarified in a short time, as Superintendent Fogarty has laid the matter before the state superintendent of education.

There is a probability that the school will be brought from West Alexandria to Eaton as a measure enacted by the late legislature makes such a change possible. If there is sufficient demand for continuance of the school and if proper accommodations are available in Eaton, it is quite likely the change to Eaton will be made, says Fogarty.

### Funeral To Be Set

Earl Harrison, 25, proprietor of the Ideal Barber Shop, died Thursday morning at Reid Memorial Hospital, Richmond, Ind., where he had been taken from his home here Tuesday evening for an operation, but which was not performed.

The body was removed to his home here Thursday for funeral and burial but as yet the funeral arrangements have not been completed. Funeral and burial probably will take place Sunday afternoon.

Harrison furnished an internal physical condition that baffled scores of surgeons and physicians who had examined him. Periods of from thirty to ninety days elapsed between evasions of his condition.

Harrison is survived by his wife, Jessie, stepdaughter, mother, Mrs. O. A. Bunting, and stepfather, of Eaton; father, who resides in Hamilton; one brother of Cincinnati, and one sister, of Los Angeles, Calif. He was married a few months ago, his wife being a daughter of John O'Byrne, proprietor of the Bazaar store, North Barron street.

### State Officials Fail to Settle Louisville Strike

LOUISVILLE, Ky., August 29.—There was little apparent hope of settlement today of the strike of unionized employees of the Louisville rail-road company which has partly tied up street car service here for nearly two weeks. After failure of Governor James D. Black, Mayor George W. Smith and other city officials to get the company to enter a conference with the union leaders, all indications pointed today toward a long drawn out affair.

Meanwhile T. J. Minary, president of the company, has expressed the belief that the backbone of the strike is broken and said that normal service will be offered within a few days.

Limited service was being offered today, the cars being manned by strike-breakers under police escort.

A statement from union headquarters denies a report that its members are returning to the company and re-iterated that 1,500 union men would remain on strike until their demands which include union recognition and better working conditions, are granted by the company.

## Quack Social Disease Nostrums are Seized By Government Agents

WASHINGTON, Aug. 29.—Four hundred and fifty seizures of so-called remedies for social disease have been made recently under the food and drug act by federal officials who have inaugurated a campaign to suppress this variety of "quack" medicine. In making this announcement today the Bureau of Chemistry of the Department of Agriculture issued a general warning that use of such "remedies" is extremely dangerous and likely to lead to a long period of suffering.

"The goods seized include a great variety of compounds," said the bureau's announcement. "Some of the labels bear the claim of the manufacturer that the contents are sure cures. Some even contain statements that cures will be effected within definite periods.
