

IF REDS PLAY .750 BALL THEY WILL WIN FLAG

If They Break Even, Giants Must Win Twenty-four and Lose Five.

YORK, Pa., Aug. 29.—With Heintz at the head of the team, the Cincinnati Reds won favor in the hearts of the local baseball fans here Thursday afternoon, in spite of the fact that they defeated a local semi-pro team, 8 to 1.

Groh's custom of putting in the entire regular line-up to start the game, and allowing them to play three or four innings before sticking in substitutes, has been very pleasing.

Following New York's dismal defeat Thursday afternoon at Philadelphia, the Reds are now in the same relative position with New York as they were when they started on their three day layoff Wednesday. With a full nine game lead, and the team playing in true championship style, it will have to win only three fourths of the remaining games to clinch, no matter what kind of a support the Giants take.

If the Reds win 19 more games this season, there can be no possible chance for the Giants to overtake them. With only 29 more games to play, the Giants have already lost 41, whereas the Reds, by losing six of their remaining 25 games, will be a full game ahead of New York at the end of the season.
