GRAIN PRICES

CHICAGO, March 23.—The morning newspaper reports and reports of nearly two million Chicago corn cancelled for May to October shipment tended to check the markets. Locals however, have avoided selling seriously. About two hundred corn seems to be expected at Chicago tomorrow. Cash corn late in the session is about unchanged to one cent lower. Temporary dips are probably due and the market may not be ready to cross \$1.60. Some hesitation is indicated overnight but to date traders still show preference for purchases. This produces rallies. The main feature overnight covers the chance of further news on the supposed corn inquiry. The entire story, however, looks like newspaper gossip.
