

SOVIET RUSSIA IS MENACE TO WORLD, SAYS CIVIC BODY

NEW YORK, March 29.—The National Civic Federation of which Judge Alton B. Parker is president, having a membership of men and women prominent in all forms of public and political endeavor, in a statement to-night came out strongly in opposition to recognition of soviet Russia. The statement, signed by more than 300 persons whose names are nationally known, will be sent to President Wilson.

It declares that the people of the United States "can not consent to admit into the family of nations or in any other way countenance this government of violence and terror." There must be no compromise between sovereign democracy and Russian Bolshevism." The declaration follows, in part:

"We believe that recognition of soviet Russia would be a repudiation of all that our national life has represented for 150 years and of all the ideals for which modern civilizations has striven for 2,000 years.

Intrigue Center Forged.

"With the recognition of the soviet regime, the presence of an ambassador and consular agents enjoying immunity (each a center of intrigue), the propaganda of the Lenin-Trotzky regime against civilization already working through so many radical and pseudo-liberal organizations, and recently augmented by an endless stream of inspired press stories from Moscow and Petrograd, would be further ramified and dangerously extended.

It is their declared intention, first to undermine and then to gain control of the organized labor unrest, the stimulation of 'strikes of protest' into general political strikes and then into revolutionary mass action for the conquest of the state." Thus we have in our own country waging deadly and underground warfare against us an enemy more dangerous and with objects infinitely more far reaching and inimical than was imperial Germany with her host of agents and spies.

"We, therefore, believe that the people of the United States, acting through their government at Washington, should now, once and for all, declare that they can not consent to admit into the family of nations or in any other way countenance this government of violence and terror.

"There must be no compromise between American democracy and Russian Bolshevism."

Chinese Cemetery Gives Noble Expression of The Great Mystery of Death

The graveyard at Chu-Fu (Shantung) is a noble expression of the dignity and mystery of death; it is impossible to think of a western cemetery with western profusion and over-decoration and gay symmetries that has touched its height. It lies a mile from the city gate. Leading to it from the gate is a broad avenue of trees spanned half way by a stone arch of exquisite carving and majestic lines. The graveyard proper—really a park—within which any member of the K'ung clan (descendants of Confucius) may be buried whether scholar or coolie, is inclosed in a pink wall. Within that wall is the spell of infinity.

On thin, eerie trees that lean rather than stand, lean rigidly and reverently, things of a twilight world never planted by a hand of man lies the mood of death. Under them are scattered the stones and tablets marking the passing of seventy-seven generations. At the farther end of the park is another wall, behind which are the tombs of Confucius his son, and his grandson. The mound of Confucius is just that; piling up of earth before which are a stone altar, a tablet inscribed with six Chinese characters, a stone urn flanked by two bronze candlesticks, along its sides are a few trees, and around it shrubbery. That is all. It is the simplicity of the sublime. One need not be Chinese to bow the head. That graveyard could stand alone as the masterpiece of a race and in itself mark that race as one that had added to mankind.

Family Temple Found
And then—then one finds the small family temple near it littered with manure, the wall of a pavilion erected for meditation broken down, stone seats rocking uncertainly, the scars of ruin everywhere. And one knows that the K'ung family has enormous holdings of valuable property, that the government remits the taxes on much of the property, and that appropriations are periodically made for the maintenance and repair of the cemetery; and that the rich heads of the family have kept nearly all of what the officials have not squeezed. And there is a sweep of bitterness and disgust that the corruption that eats through the whole texture of life in China would have gnawed so deep as this.

Here is all that remains of him. These people know as God; here are the men of his blood, raised above all others of their nation because of that; and it is impossible not to believe calloused to all decent appeal a peo-

"Black-Faced" Watches Can Move Locomotive

If you own a radium-dial watch with luminous figures and hands, then you are the possessor of a vast power plant of no mean proportions. There is sufficient radium on your watch dial

to haul your train homeward if it could be properly applied.

As the matter stands the innocent-looking radium dial does not seem to possess any extraordinary amount of concentrated energy, but this is only apparently the case, and not actually so, for the reason that while the amount of activity manifested by the radium paint on the dial is small, this effect will keep up for 2,500 years,

provided the zinc sulphide, with which the radium is mixed so as to produce a glow, hold out that long. The zinc sulphide in most cases given out in about eight or ten years.

Now, if we could but find a way to make the radium release all its energy in a few hours, instead of spreading it over 2,500 years, it would not be difficult to make a motor that would utilize the energy.

NEW ANTI-AIRCRAFT SHELL


POWER OF EUROPE'S RIVERS.


