

AMERICAN ARMADA TO IMPRESS WORLD SAY NAVY LEADERS

WASHINGTON, Oct. 18.—The two great fleets that the Navy Department plans to send around the world next June will be the most powerful that have been assembled under the American flag, it was stated today. Each will include approximately 110 units, selected with the greatest care from 200 or more available.

As described by officials today, this stupendous armada is aimed to be "a spectacle that will impress the world with America's naval power."

The Atlantic fleet, which first will visit South America and South American ports, it was learned, will include the dreadnoughts Pennsylvania, Arizona, Oklahoma, Nevada, Kansas, Utah, Florida, Delaware, North Dakota, Michigan, South Carolina, Minnesota and New Hampshire. A sufficient number of battle ships will be added to increase the total.

Big Type Ships.
The full number of first-class fighting craft will be 20. Ten cruisers, 50 destroyers and 10 auxiliaries will complete the ensemble.

Impressive as is the proposed Atlantic fleet, it will be excelled in fighting power by the Pacific fleet. The most powerful unit in that force will be the new dreadnought Tennessee, put into commission this week and now taking on torpedoes at Newport preparatory for her trip through the Panama Canal.

Tennessee is Latest.
The Tennessee measures 32,000 tons, being more than twice the size and having four times the fighting strength of the battle ship Connecticut, which headed President Theodore Roosevelt's fleet around the globe. Next will come the new super-dreadnoughts Idaho and Mississippi, followed close in gun power by the New Mexico, which has the distinction of being the only dreadnought in the world driven by electric power.

The dreadnoughts Wyoming, Arkansas, Texas and New York also have been assigned to the Pacific fleet, which will include 12 additional battle ships.

Eight cruisers, approximately 80 destroyers and 10 auxiliary ships will complete the force. It will visit Honolulu and Samoa before proceeding to Australia, New Zealand, Tasmania and Van Dieman's Land.

This grand maneuver, which will be complete only after the two great fleets have exchanged a number of their units somewhere between South Africa and Van Dieman's Land, will occupy a year.

Primer for First Voters

1. Vote early.
2. The polls are open from 6 a. m. to 6 p. m.
3. Vote in the precinct where you live.
4. If you don't know your precinct, call up 2020, county auditor's office for information.
5. According to law, every employee of a factory or business institution must be given four hours in which to vote.
6. Vote straight party ticket.
7. Why? Because it is the quickest and safest way to vote.
8. How do you vote the straight party ticket?
9. By making a mark inside the circle at the top of the ballot.
10. Remember, this is the only mark you make on the ballot if you vote the straight ticket.
11. If you want to "scratch the ticket," do NOT mark within the circle. Put a mark in the square opposite the names of the candidates.
12. Do not cross off any name on the ballot. This will lose your vote.
13. Women should give their names as "Mary Smith" not "Mrs. John Smith."
14. Do not ask for a Republican ballot or a Democratic ballot. All ballots are the same and will be given to you as you enter the polls without asking.
15. Do not discuss politics outside or inside the polls. If you do your vote may be challenged.
16. Do not tell people what your politics are. For instance, do not say "I am going to vote the Republican ticket," or the Democratic or the Socialist or any other ticket.
17. Be sure to fold your ballot correctly. If you do not know how you will be told at the polls how to do so.
18. If you spoil your ballot, you can say so, hand the ballot back and another one will be given you.
19. All women who can do so should vote in the morning to give men and women, who cannot get to the polls until late in the afternoon, plenty of time.

KENTUCKY PRISONERS MAKE MOONSHINE WHISKY IN JAIL

HENDERSON, Ky., Oct. 18.—Investigating the odor of burning rags, Jailor Rod Davis discovered a moonshine still in the city jail. Prisoners had made their fire from pieces of blankets and had distilled more than a pint of liquor from corn bread saved from jail rations.

New Safety Instruments Adopted by Mine Bureau

CHARLESTON, W. Va., Oct. 18.—The West Virginia Bureau of Mines which is credited by experts with the best equipment in the country for rescuing entombed miners has just added to its outfit for that work three new pieces of apparatus—a geophone, a carbon monoxide detector and a brass encased thermometer.

The geophone is similar to a physician's stethoscope. As the stethoscope is used to detect irregularities in the human body by sound, so the geophone is used to detect earth sounds. In this way entombed miners can be located noting the direction from which the sound vibrations come.

The brass-encased thermometer records maximum and minimum temperatures whereby it can be ascertained when it is safe to enter mines sealed to smother fires. Hitherto, it has been a problem to know when to enter the shafts, but with the thermometer dropped through a hole in the barricade, this can be determined easily.

The carbon monoxide detector is considered the most important piece of apparatus from the point of protecting the lives of rescuers. The gas is detected by a color tube and a color scale on the instrument. Formerly canary birds were used, but their use was not entirely satisfactory, as the birds often succumbed to other gases, while a color detector instrument shows no other gas than carbon monoxide present. One-tenth of one per cent of the gas is said to be fatal to a human being.

Compulsory Farming Text Of Proposed Argentine Law

BUENOS AIRES, Oct. 18.—Compulsory farming is provided for in a bill just introduced in the chamber of deputies with the idea of forming an economic army to be composed of the youth of Argentina who are not called into the army and navy under the conscription law. If this measure becomes a law every young man in the country who does not take up a rifle or go to sea will be set to raising wheat and doing other farm labor.

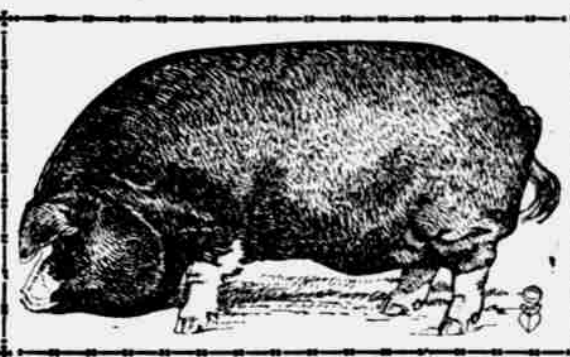
Although compulsory military service is in force in Argentina, only a small part of the young men actually go into the service at present, those being selected by lot, and as a result, according to La Nacion, there is some dissatisfaction because of the exemptions. If the new law is passed, says the newspaper, it will result in the cheapening of food stuffs and some of the vast tracts of uncultivated public land in Argentina can be put to producing food.
