

GUATEMALAN ENVOY HAS NO OBJECTION TO CABRERA PROBE

WASHINGTON, Dec. 10.—Dr. Julio Bianchi, Guatemalan minister to the United States, announced today that he would inform the state department

that his government had no objection to the fullest investigation of the detention and treatment of Dr. Estrera Cabrera, former president of the republic. The minister's announcement was based on publication of the resolution presented yesterday by Senator Moses representative of New Hampshire, calling upon the state department for such information as it had on the subject.

Senator Moses charges in his resolution that Dr. Cabrera, after his surrender, was thrown into "a common

jail and there confined in a cell used only for the imprisonment of dangerous criminals," in violation of an agreement drawn up and signed in the American legation. Under the terms of this agreement the resolution asserts, Dr. Cabrera was to have been lodged in the military academy and was given "the most solemn and ample guarantees, for his life and property." The reason for placing Dr. Cabrera in jail, according to the resolution, was that his property might be despoiled.

It also is alleged that the deposed

president was deprived of all legal rights and privileges and the resolution states that "there is reason to believe that Cabrera continues to be maltreated in every way, in violation of the solemn pledges given under the protection of the American legation." Minister Bianchi in his announcement today denied that Dr. Cabrera was being held in a prison cell. He said the former president occupied a suite of three rooms, which included a personal office.

FIND BUBONIC PLAGUE

RIO DE JANEIRO, Dec. 10.—Bubonic plague has been discovered in three states in the north of Brazil, Alagoas, Rio Grande do Norte and Ceara, according to official reports. Offers of assistance by the federal government have been accepted by the state government.

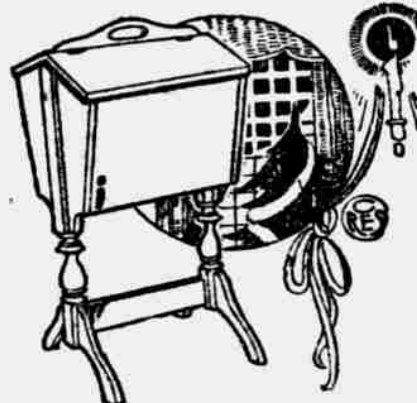

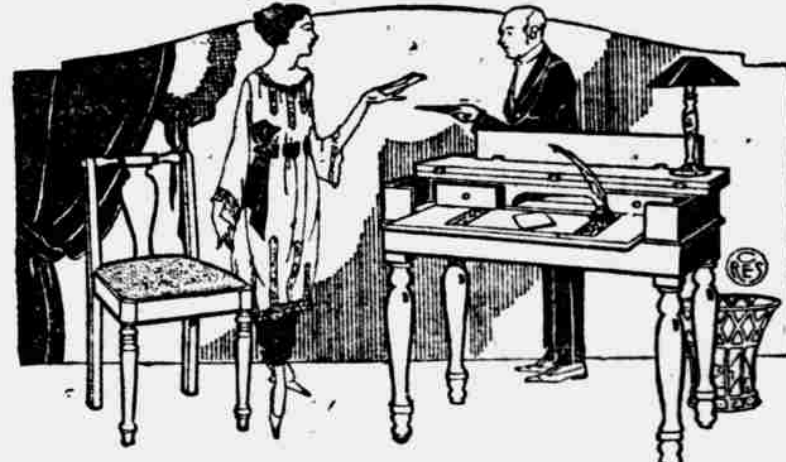
