

JOSEPH BARR, FARMER, CHOSEN MEMBER OF AGRICULTURAL BOARD

INDIANAPOLIS, June 24.—Governor McCray has announced the appointment of Joseph L. Barr of Bruceville as a member of the state board of agriculture. Mr. Barr succeeds I. Newt Brown of Franklin, who resigned as a member of the board from the Eighth district last week to become recording secretary of the board. The law provides that the secretary shall not be a member of the board.

Mr. Barr is a farmer and business man of southern Indiana. He has been active in agricultural work of the state, and his appointment is regarded with favor by persons interested in work of the board. The new board member at one time was Republican chairman for the second congressional district.

First Unrestricted Choice.
The appointment of Mr. Barr marks the first time Governor McCray has had a free hand in naming a member of the new state board. Under the provisions of the law creating the state board, which was approved by the last session of the Legislature, the Governor was required to name all the sixteen members of the old quasi public board as members of the new state board.

The appointment of Mr. Barr is in line with the policy of state officials to have the state fair run on a business basis under state control. It is known that the Governor is deeply interested in the development of the state fair and wishes to further the work of the new state body in its management. Having served as a member of the old quasi public board for several terms, the governor is thoroughly familiar with the duties of the fair board.

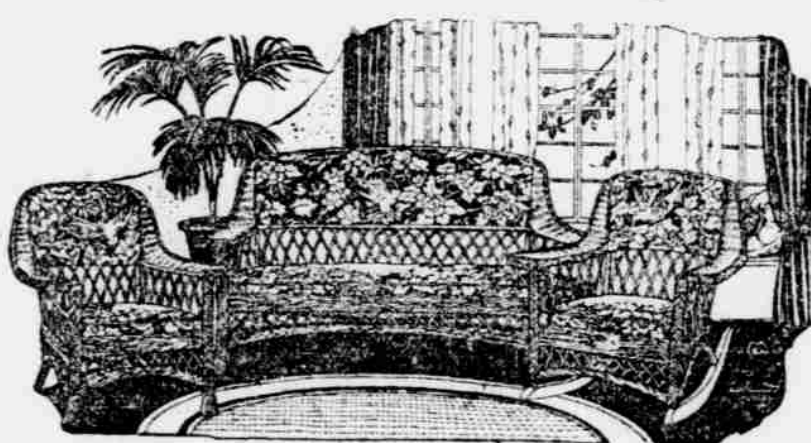
