

WILSON TURNS TO PLANS FOR TOUR

Will Emphasize Need For Peace As Factor in Cutting Prices.

WASHINGTON, Aug. 9.—President Wilson, having handed the high cost of living problem over to congress, at least for the time being, turned his attention today to plans for his tour of the United States. It was believed, however, that he would touch on the high cost of living in his speeches.

In his address to congress yesterday, the president said there can be no real peace prices until there is peace. He is expected to use this argument in his campaign.

Before Wilson goes on tour, he may hold a series of white house conferences with representatives of both capital and labor, to discuss present economic conditions and the remedy for certain evils. In his speech he said many things should be corrected in the relations between capital and labor and that he was ready to confer on the matters, with "men who know what they're talking about."
