

## MEXICO MUST PAY FOR DISORDERS

Revolutions Result in Damage  
Bill of 18,000,000 Pesos  
Against Government.

MEXICO CITY, Aug. 15.—Claims made by the various nations against the Mexican government for property damages suffered during revolutionary disorders amount at the present time to 18,259,529 pesos, according to a statement made public by the department of the treasury based on data secured from the bureau of claims which is administering the adjustments. Spanish claimants head the list both in numbers and in damages asked. Americans rank sixth. The distribution of the claimants and the amount of their claims is as follows: Spanish, \$1,122,927 pesos; Turkish, \$1,168,599 pesos; German, \$445,908 pesos; French, \$282,841 pesos; Italian, \$272,457 pesos; American, \$139,914 pesos; Chinese, \$35,692 pesos; Guatemalan, \$29,000 pesos; English, \$9,967 pesos; Dutch, \$7,700 pesos; Australian, \$2,225 pesos; Mexican, \$5,537,364 pesos. The newspaper El Universal in commenting on these figures calls attention to the relative positions of American, British and French claimants and suggests that many of these nations have refrained from making formal requests, intending to attempt reclamation through the diplomatic channels of their respective governments.

## GERMANS ORDER GIRLS TO STAY AWAY FROM YANKS

With The American Forces In Germany, July 21.—(Correspondence)—Posters written in German and warning German girls against associating with Americans appeared recently in several public places in Cologne and other towns on the Rhine, the girls being urged to refrain from making the acquaintance of soldiers regardless of the fact that the treaty of peace had been signed. At various times posters have been put up threatening indiscreet girls with punishment of one kind or another.

American officers who have investigated say the Germans are determined that girls who associate with the soldiers shall have their names known to the population and that several secret societies have been formed for that purpose. Intelligence officers say that on several occasions the names of girls who are on the records of the German police for associating with Americans have been read to the congregations at Sunday morning church services. In other villages the practice of posting the girls' names in public places was inaugurated some time ago.

The officers assert that blacklists of the girls' names have been prepared and are being kept for future use, after the Americans are gone.
