

CHAMPION HOG BRINGS \$10,000

Sale Sets a Precedent in Poland China Class in Country.

Through the sale of the champion Poland China hog, Outpost for a consideration of \$10,000, C. F. Melsh, hog fancier of Union township of this county, has been placed in the foremost ranks of the Poland China Breeders of the country. White Bros., of Mt. Carmel, Ill., were the purchasers and the sale sets a precedent for the county. Outpost is considered the grand champion of all hogs one year of age or younger. In a statement made Wednesday following the completion of the negotiations for the sale of the hog, Mr. Melsh said that the cash consideration does not represent the entire value of the animal in as much as he has 24 of the first progeny of the hog, which together with the possibilities of fall litters of ten sows will give the uninitiated some idea of the intermixture of the blood of this almost perfect animal throughout his herd.

AMERICANIZATION DAY IS PLANNED

Civic Organizations and
Chamber of Commerce
in Charge.

Arrangements for South Bend's observance of Americanization day, May 1, were being made Wednesday by officials of the Chamber of Commerce and other civic organizations of the city.

Mayor Carson plans to issue a proclamation within the next few days, calling upon citizens generally to join in the observance of the occasion. The schools of the city are also to participate in the observance.

county are to join with South Bend in the celebration. The tentative plans for the observance calls for appropriate exercises at the public schools? Buttons with the words, "No Red Without the White and Blue," are to be distributed throughout the county. W. W. Borden, superintendent of public instruction, will have charge of the participation of the schools in the observance of the day. W. E. Chandler will supervise the Mishawaka participation in the celebration.

The celebration of the day is to be nation wide. Gov. Goodrich is expected to issue a proclamation, calling upon Hoosiers in every part of the state to join in the day's observance. Mayor Carson's proclamation is expected to follow the one to be issued by Gov. Goodrich.

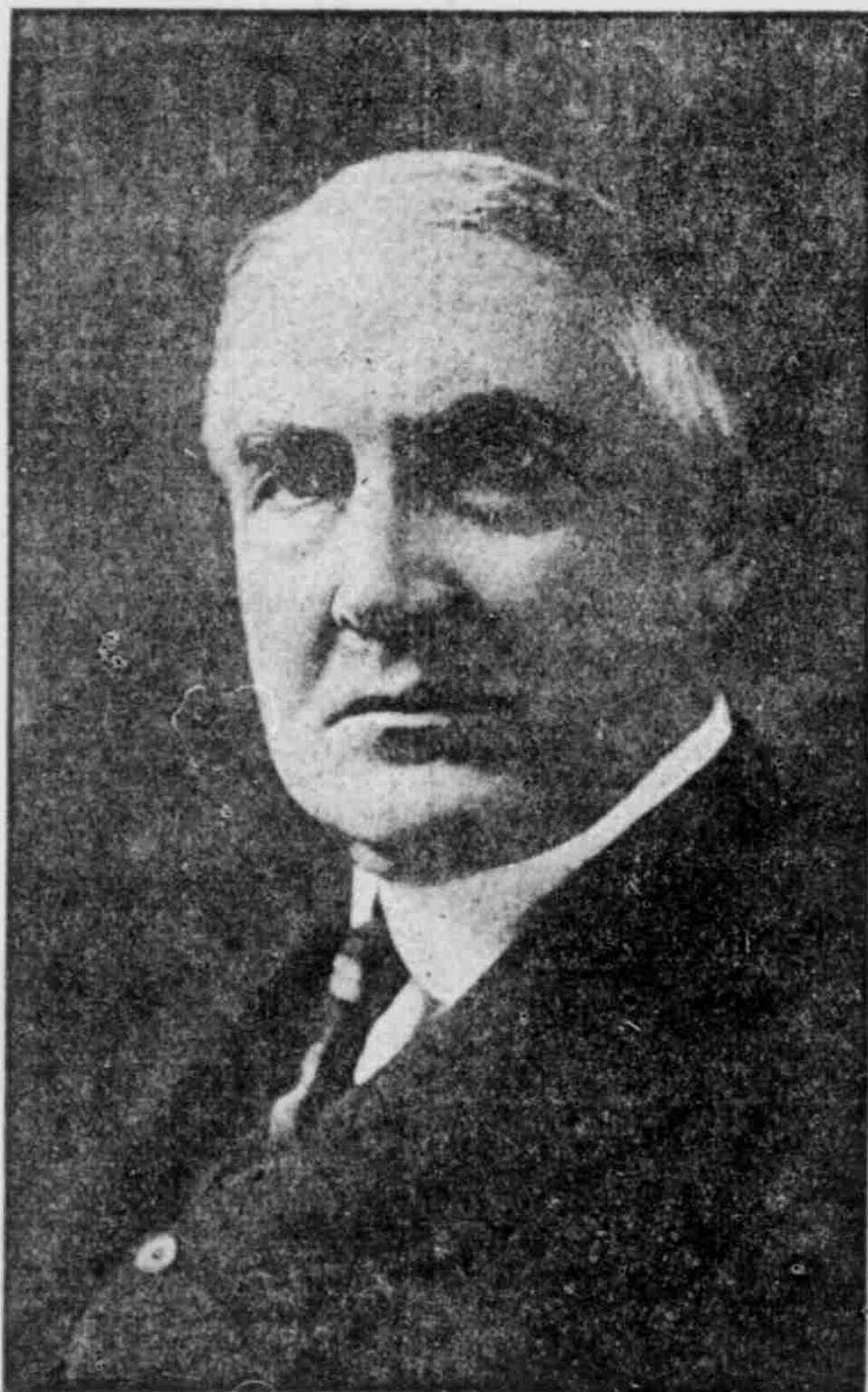

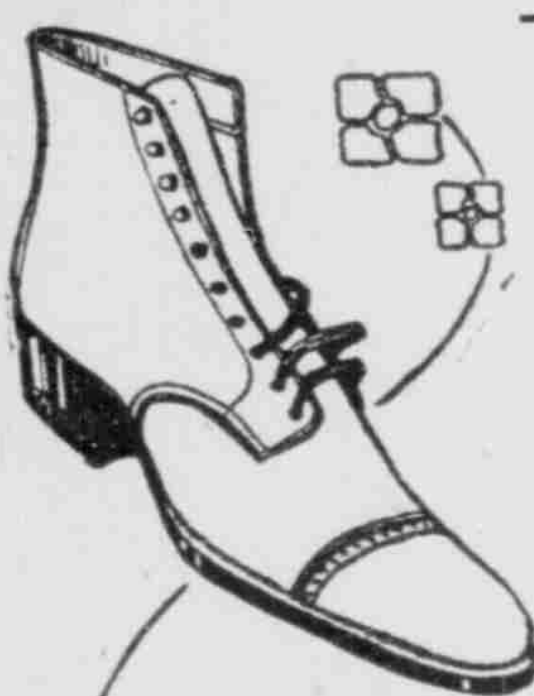

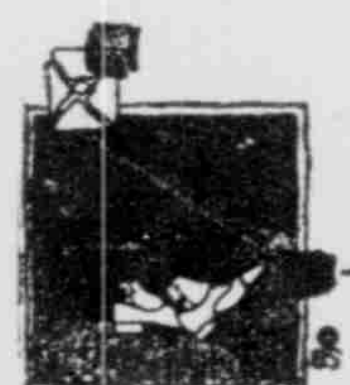
