

## CHAMPION HOG BRINGS \$10,000

Sale Sets a Precedent in Poland China Class in Country.

Through the sale of the champion Poland China hog, Outpost for a consideration of \$10,000, C. F. Reish, fancier of the township of this country, has broken the foremost ranks of the Poland China Breeders of the country. White Bros., of Mt. Carmel, Ill., were the purchasers and the sale sets a precedent for the county. Outpost is considered the grand champion of all hogs one year of age or younger.

In a statement made Wednesday following the completion of the negotiations for the sale of the hog, Mr. Reish said that the cash consideration does not represent the entire value of the animal in as much as he has 24 of the first progeny of the hog, which together with the possibilities of fall litters of ten sows will give the uninformed some idea of the intermixing of the blood of this almost perfect animal throughout his herd.

Mr. Reish declared that he plans to maintain his herd on the present basis of merit and will branch out with the acquisition of a Holstein Dairy cattle herd.


