PASTOR IN OVERALLS FLAYS PROFITEERS

Takes Stand Against Illegitimate Business, Sunday Desecration, Immodest Dress.

Rev. G. W. Titus, pastor of the First Christian church, appeared in overalls at the evening service Sunday before a large congregation and in the course of his sermon took a few effective knocks at the profiteers. In the course of his remarks he stated that in wearing overalls he was not taking the role of the sensationalist, nor was it in some a trick to catch the crowd. He took his stand with the great masses of citizens over the country in a protest against illegitimate profiteering.

He was of the opinion that the movement, one in the church, should take the initiative and for once anyhow, prove to the toilers, victims of the profiteers, that the church is with them all the way.

Mr. Titus said it was not the first time he had worn overalls. He had done so in the foundry, in the factory, and on ship board for 20 years.

The speaker referred to the mad, all-consuming, burning passion for making money as one of the most flagrant evils of the day.

The slogan was "get the money." It had gripped our lives, our souls, and like a cancer had eaten its way into every fibre of our lives.

"For the sake of money, we sell their honor; they climb to riches upon the bones of their fellowmen. For this cause, women, whose duties in the home where she is to kindle the holy fires of love and affection, brush these things aside and give up their lives for the ascension of mammon."

Mr. Titus denounced the desecration of the Sabbath, remarking that pleasure is all right, but God must come first.
