DIRECTOR NAMED FOR TRUCK FARM

P. J. McGervey of Government Bureau Will Direct Experimental Station.

P. J. McGervey, an agent from the horticulture investigation bureau of the department of agriculture has been named as director of the government truck crop experimental station on the A. C. Steenburg farm at Valley Garden and has already

taken charge. The new director announced Monday that the 11 acres available for experimental truck farming will be divided into four sections, cabbage, celery, onions and lettuce being the four varieties to be grown. Each section will be subdivided into 44 plots for the purpose of giving each plot a different fertilizer treatment.

The experimental station director reports that progress has been materially hindered by the weather conditions, it being too wet to work the soil but active work will be started as soon as the present rain spell lets up.
