RED CROSS CHAPTER

Lake Division News Points
Out What City Has Done
and is Doing.

The Lake Division News of the Red Cross pays the following tribute to the Mishawaka chapter of the society:

Mishawaka (Ind.) chapter is doing a splendid piece of civic work in their new community center just opened in that city.

The center has been made possible by the generosity of public spirited citizens who donated funds for fitting out suitable quarters and also by the willingness of the teaching staff to give their services.

Every evening and several afternoons the center is open, and through its medium the Americanization problem of the city is being led to a partial solution. Already three foreigners have taken out citizenship papers as a result of instructions given there.

A regular schedule of classes and recreation is planned for the week, the evening's study or program starting promptly at 7:30 o'clock. Monday and Friday, classes in English, reading, writing and arithmetic are taught by a former school teacher of long experience. Tuesday evening is given over to athletics under direction of an ex-soldier.

One of the high school teachers conducts on Wednesday classes in American laws and information necessary before the man of foreign birth can take out his citizenship papers. Community singing occupies the Thursday, evening session, and Saturday is a social evening. Sunday afternoon there is an informal "at home" gathering.

Special classes for men employed nights are conducted in the elementary branches Monday and Friday afternoons. Special teachers have volunteered for the advanced pupils. For some time Mishawaka has felt the need for a common meeting place where foreign and native-born citizens might meet to take up the study of English and civics. This need is met by the Red Cross Community center.
