

SCIENCE CHURCH OFFICIALS FILE MAJORITY REPORT

General Welfare Committee
Completes Eight Months'
Investigation.

NEW YORK, April 25.—Supporting the manual of the mother church and the Christian Science organization as projected by Mary Baker Eddy, the church committee on general welfare after eight months' investigation of the denomination's affairs in Boston, made public a majority and minority report here Wednesday. The findings aggregated 25,000 words and are said to be "encouraging and constructive."

Several Recommendations.
Among the recommendations are: That no member of the mother church shall receive for official service in excess of an aggregate of \$10,000 a year; that there be "closer and more open relationship between officials and members;" that officials of the mother church shall discontinue class teaching during the term of office; that "as soon as present conditions will permit, rotation in office and equality of the sexes where permissible, be applied to all the official positions of the mother church."

In the last named recommendation much would apply to the directors, the period of service in a particular office would be limited to five years and the total of official service not to exceed 10 years.

Minority Report.
The minority report, which agrees with the majority report in many particulars, disagreed in regard to making the report public. It was held that the committee assumed a responsibility it did not possess in reporting to the entire membership instead of the board of directors.

Investigation of the Christian Science Publishing society, the trustees of which for more than a year have been in litigation with the board of directors, the committee states was rendered impossible because of a request on the part of the trustees "that the proposed examination and report be deferred until the pending controversy has been disposed of."

The committee in summarizing its report says that it investigated seven subjects, viz: One, administration; two, guardianship of church unions; three, board of trusteeship and education; four, the Christian Science Benevolent association; five, trustees under the will of Mary Baker Eddy; six, magna charta; and seven, church government.




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The Kitchen—One Cooking Stove, One Kitchen Table, 15 Yards of Linoleum, and Two Kitchen Chairs.


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


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
