thousands of dollars.

Work on the repair of the Northwest District Sewer will be underway soon. The Board has granted sewer connection privileges to Tomlinson Motor Court. The connection fee will be \$5,000 which will be applied to the overall cost of the sewer construction.

A new elevated water storage tank will be erected in the near Northeast corner of Meadowood Park. It will be of modern design, (sphere shape on a pedestal). It will have a capacity of 500,000 gallons. The tower will be 90 feet high with a 37 foot head range. Pittsburgh Des-Mones Steel Company were the successful bidders with a proposal of \$92,620.

The Marion County Tax Adjustment Board has reduced the proposed tax rate twelve (.12) cents on each one-hundred (\$100) dollars property valuation. The State Tax Board will review it again in October. The Town rate as it now stands is \$1.11 per \$100.
