JOHNSON COUNTY TAXES FOR 1841.

THE Treasurer and Collector of Johnson county, Indiana, hereby gives notice that the duplicate for the present year is now in his hands. The amount of tax levied is.

For State purposes, on each one hundred dollars valuation, 45 cents, poll tax 75 cents; for County purposes, on each one hundred dollars valuation 10 cents, poll tax 50 cents; Road tax, on each one hundred dollars valuation, 5 cents.

For the purpose of receiving taxes he will attend at the usual places of holding elections in the several townships in said county, on the following days, to-wit:

In Hensley township, the 1st day of October; In Union township, the 22d day of October; In White river township, the 4th day of October; In Pleasant township, the 5th day of October; In Clark township, the 6th day of October; In Franklin township, the 7th day of October; In Blue river township, the 8th day of October; In Nineval township, the 9th of October.

All tax payers will find it to their interest to attend to this notice, as all who neglect it will be under the necessity of going to Franklin to make payment. And if any should defer payment till after the 25th of December next, the law requires a penalty of ten per cent. on the amount to be collected for the use of the County treasury. Distress of property may be made for taxes after the 25th of December, in which case, the Collector's fees will be the same as the fees of Constables in like cases; but I hope none will so far forget their own interest as to render it necessary for me to resort to this method of collecting.
