## TELEVISION TREMORS

Riley Hospital Treats Nearly One-Third of Indiana's Polio Victims  
As Indiana Carries Out The Riley Centennial Research Fund Campaign

(Upper Left) While hundreds of volunteers sponsored by the Riley Memorial Association accept gifts for a state-wide fund to underwrite a research program at James Whitcomb Riley Hospital for Children, polio-stricken children still manage a smile in the face of a disease which medical science has not yet learned to curb. Here, Richard, age 12, laughs at the antics of "Courageous George," a comic character whose actions are controlled by means of a ceiling film projector run by a button which Richard holds in his left hand. The plane landed in a very unorthodox manner in the middle of North Lee street in the Pennsylvania city, and Piechoske and his fiancee were seriously injured. Firemen of the Philadelphia department stood by and pour water on the wreckage to prevent any fire that might result from the accident from spreading to nearby buildings and threatening this section of Philadelphia.
