

BOND SALE NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that the Trustee and Advisory Board of

Turkey Creek Township of Kosciusko County, Indiana, will meet at the office of the Township Trustee in the Syracuse Grade

School Building, in the Town of Syracuse, Indiana, on the 2nd day of November 1949, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P. M., and at said time and place receive bids on and sell to the highest bidder therefor the following described bonds:

An issue of bonds of the Turkey Creek School Township of Kosciusko County, Indiana, designated "School Building Bonds of 1949", in the amount of \$40,000.00. Said bonds are to be dated as of November 2, 1949, and will bear interest at a rate not exceeding 3% per annum (the exact rate to be determined by bidding) which interest is payable on July 1, 1951 and semi-annually thereafter on January 1 and July 1 of each year. Said bonds will be in the denomination of \$1,000.00, and will mature as follows: \$4,000.00 on July 1, 1951 and \$4,000.00 each and every six months thereafter to and including January 1, 1956.

Bidders for these bonds will be required to name the rate of interest which the bonds are to bear, not exceeding 3% per annum. Such interest rate must be in multiples of 1/4 of 1%, and not more than one interest rate shall be named by each bidder. The bonds will be awarded to the highest responsible bidder who has submitted his bid in accordance herewith. The highest bidder will be the one who offers the lowest net interest cost to the School Township, to be determined by computing the total interest on all of the bonds to their maturities and deducting therefrom the premium bid, if any. Each bid must be accompanied by a certified check in the amount of \$500.00, payable to Turkey Creek School Township of Kosciusko County, Indiana. In the event the bidder to whom said bonds are awarded shall fail or refuse to accept delivery of the same within five days after being notified that the bonds are ready for delivery, said check and the proceeds thereof shall become the property of the School Township and shall be considered as its liquidated damages growing out of such default. No bid for less than the par value of said bonds, including accrued interest to the date of delivery at the rate named in the bid, will be considered. The right is reserved to reject any and all bids.

Said bonds are being issued under the provisions of Section 65-313 Burns Indiana Statutes 1933, for the purpose of provid-

ing funds to pay the cost of remodeling and improvement of the Syracuse High School Building and the equipment thereof, the construction and equipment of an addition to the said building, and the acquisition and improvement of additional school grounds. Said bonds are the direct obligations of the School Township, payable out of unlimited, ad valorem taxes to be levied and collected on all of the taxable property within the School Township.

The approving opinion of Ross McCord Lee & Miller, bond counsel, of Indianapolis, Indiana, will be furnished to the successful bidder at the expense of the Township. No conditional bids will be considered.

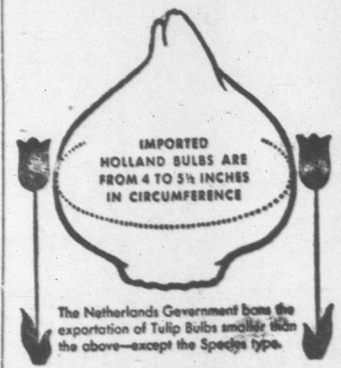

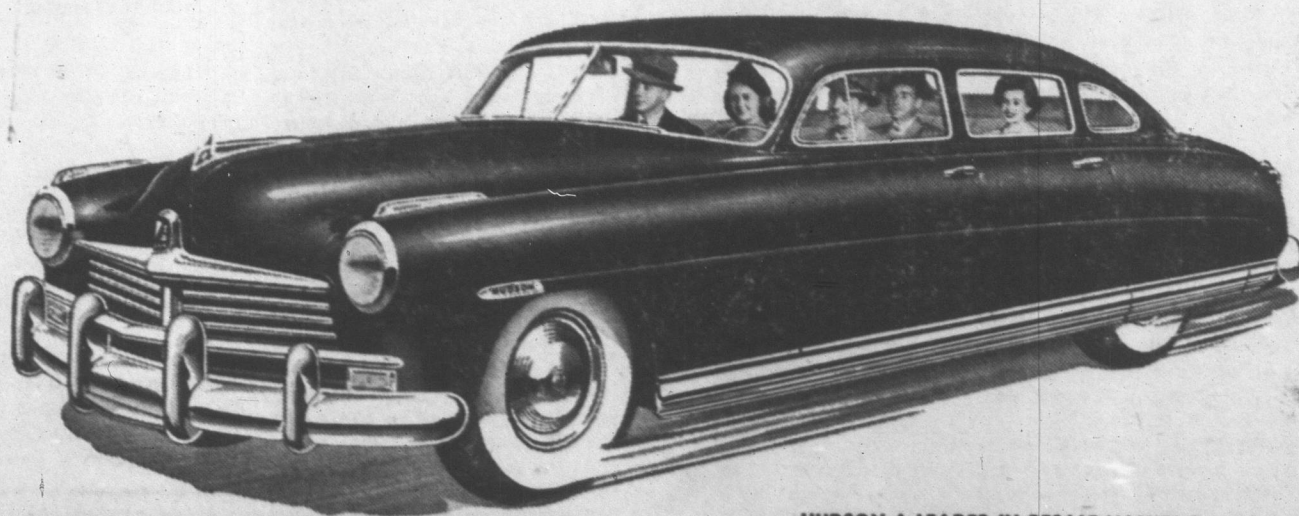
