rides—will join regular "wolf pack" patrols of marked cars in guarding the traffic trouble spots over the state. Both the plain and marked police vehicles will be manned by state policemen in full uniform.

"We're taking off the gloves against the small per cent of drivers who risk the lives of others," Supt. Jessup asserted.

Troopers driving the unidentified cars will watch for motorists who make a practice of intentionally disregarding traffic laws when a police car is not in sight. Prime targets will be the drivers observed in moving traffic infractions, including speeding, following too close, passing on a hill or curve, weaving in and out of traffic and disregarding signals.

The enforcement technique is legal, he said, and was devised to extend the effectiveness of the department's relatively small patrol force. It will be used again the weekend of November 20-21 and during the long Thanksgiving holiday weekend, November 24-28.

The phantom fleet will team up with regular State Police patrol cars on high accident-frequency state and federal highways. Troopers will maintain radio contact and concentrate their enforcement efforts against violators. Sheriff's and city police departments will aid.

"Our objective is to protect the majority of motorists who observe the rules," Supt. Jessup pointed out. Drivers who establish bad driving records may forfeit their driving permits, he warned.

## Vet Flood Sufferers Can Get Assistance from VA

Word War II and Post Korea veterans in Indiana whose homes were damaged or lost during the recent floods may get assistance through the VA Loan Guaranty Program. George L. McWilliams, of the South Bend VA Office announced today.

The President has declared the areas of Indiana affected by the recent floods as major disaster areas. These areas are located in Elkhart, Lake, LaPorte, Marshall, and Starke Counties.

The Administrator of the Housing and Home Finance Agency has informed VA that as a result of the President's action the Federal National Mortgage Association (FNMA) will make special credit aid available to veterans made homeless by the floods.

Further information concerning these credit aids to veterans who were affected by the floods may be obtained by writing or visiting the VA Indianapolis Regional Office, McWilliams said.

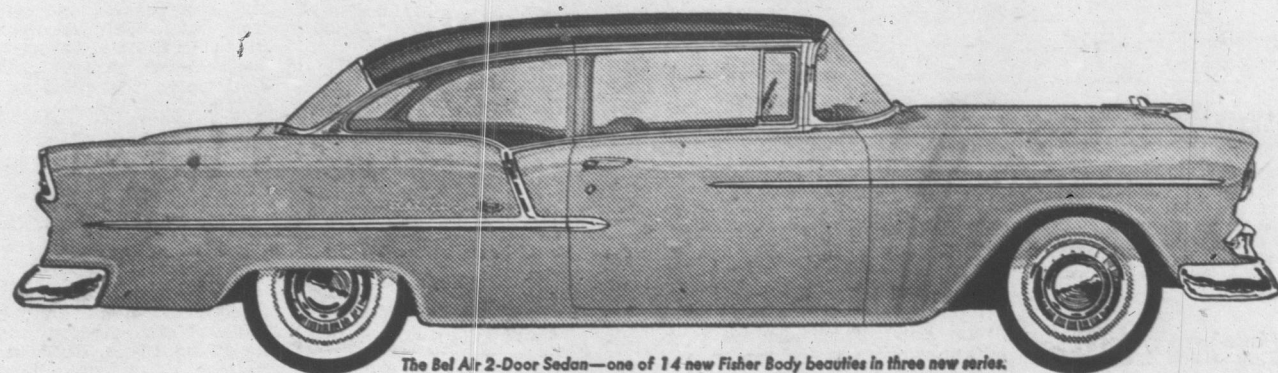

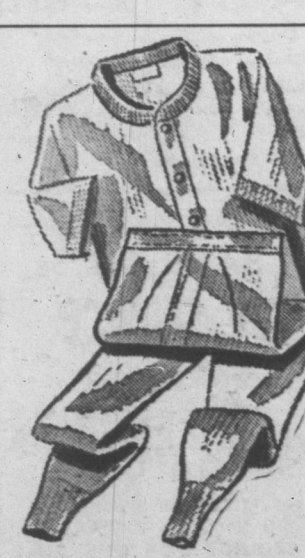
